## USE OF POUND STERLING IN EAST AFRICA.

### Urged by the Governor of Uganda.

#### THE GOVERNORS' CONFERENCE.

#### Control of Road Traffic Accepted as a Principle of Legislation.

The following communique relating to some of the items discussed by the recent Conference of Governors was issued for publication by the Secretary to the Conference on Friday:

"The Governors' Conference at their recent meeting sent a telegram of greeting to His Majesty The King in the following terms:—

"The Governors of Kenya, Tanganyika and Uganda assembled in accordance with the invitation to present their humble duty and to tender respectful greetings to His Majesty The King and to His Majesty The Queen. They wish to forward the expressions of the devotion and loyalty of all sections and communities of Your Majesty's subjects in these British East African Dependencies. They congratulate Your Majesty on your recovery from your recent severe illness, and wish that Your Majesty and the Queen may long continue to watch over the welfare and strengthen the ties which unite the various sections of the Empire."

The following reply was received:—

"The message for His Majesty commencing by telegram on 18th January has been laid before His Majesty the King and I have commended His Majesty to convey to you an expression of his appreciation of the loyal sentiment contained in it.—Parliament."

The following information regarding some of the items which were discussed at the recent Governors' Conference may be of interest.

**Grading by Officers.**

It will be remembered that at the Governors' Conference in 1929 a resolution was adopted that field trials should be afforded to Administrative Officers of a certain seniority to study conditions in other dependencies by the granting of extended leave and possibly certain travelling and other concessions. At a recent meeting of the Senate Committee of Kenya in March a request was made that financial assistance should be given by Government to selected officers when visiting other Colonies in Africa in order to study existing conditions. The Conference also discussed the proposal presented by the Senior Commissioner's Standing Advisory Committee (1928) resolutions and further field trials should be afforded to Officers drawn extended leave and possibly certain other concessions. At a recent meeting of the Senate Committee of Kenya a request was made that financial assistance should be given by Government to selected officers when such cases would be considered on their merits and that suitable allowances and travelling expenses would not be granted, unless the same was being for some special purpose which had been approved by Government.

**Customs Seal.**

The situation with regard to registered custom seals in Uganda and Tanganyika was discussed and it was agreed that there was no objection to the various territories to adopt a similar procedure in the

Africa was examined and the various methods being used in the different territories in connection with this trade were noted. The opinion was generally held that the best plan would be to grade skins at the coast but unfortunately there was no practical objection to this method. The procedure in force in the three territories was as follows:—

In Tanganyika there was considerable propaganda for the proper curing of hides; natives were also being trained by the Veterinary Department in drying and similar work, and a number of skins had been bought on behalf of the Veterinary Department which were afterwards sold in the East African market. It was proposed in the future it was proposed that the market who could not sell hides, after which they would be put up for auction; the system might develop in time the system of co-operative selling. The question of landing charges for the buying of wild hides was being considered. Generally speaking it was considered that the methods which had been adopted in Tanganyika had improved the trade and given great satisfaction to natives.

In Uganda great difficulty had been experienced in buying wool not give a higher price for better quality skins and it was agreed that some form of grading at least could be introduced. A special export tax, penalizing the most qualities of wool, the introduction of ruling prices for grades would probably be necessary in order to introduce into Uganda.

The position in Kenya had been clearly set forth in a report of a committee which had reported in 1929 and in the minutes of the meeting of the Elders and Eldess Section of the Merchants Chamber of Commerce and of Agriculture which had been held in February 1929.

The whole question was discussed and the advantages of compulsory grading of a satisfactory method could be devised was recognized. It was agreed that further information in connection with this matter should be obtained from the Empire Marketing Board, the British Institute, or any other organization which would be able to supply reliable information and that this should be recommended to the Empire Marketing Board.

The requirements and costs of European Education in the three territories were discussed. It was thought to be desirable in Tanganyika a European School should now be built at Moshi and that an similar was also being built at Arusha which would also cater for the education of children sent to the institutions of Tanganyika and Uganda. It was agreed that the Kenya Government should study the local conditions in the parents and that the parents should then settle with the Government of their own territory up to the proportion which they themselves should find. In the event of the Kenya Government meeting any difficulty in collecting the fees, the other Government should offer every facility. It was also agreed that the Government should apply with regard to Malawi.

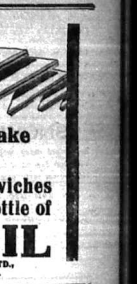
