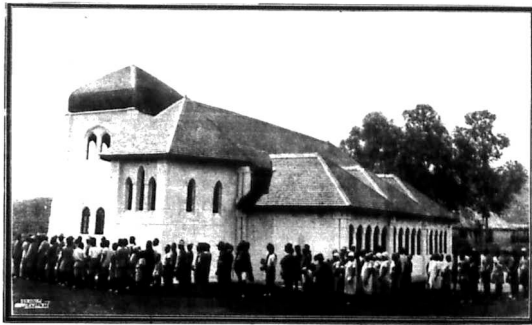

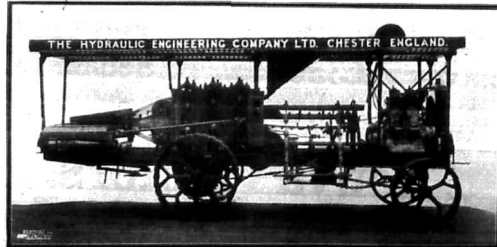

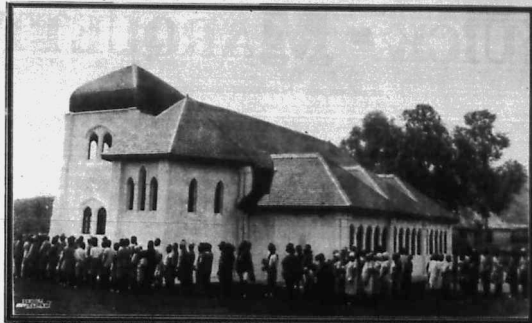

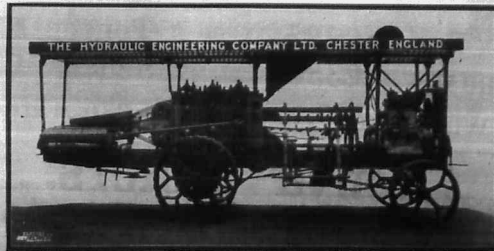

Nairobi Railway Club's Ltd.

During the past year sports in Nairobi has received considerable impetus due to the activities of the Nairobi Railway Athletic Club. In recent weeks only a few weeks have been over fairly marked by the inception of a Rugby club, and the promotion of an outdoor gathering which all the indications being the forerunner of an East African Olympiad.

Cultivating Health

Physical training provides an outlet for superfluous energy, and by providing a gymnasium on the scale to be met with at the Railway Club, the power that are being built along stable lines.

which we were completely, as was when, as was not infrequently the case, it was desired to ascertain the antecedents of a Race Horse or Blood Mare with a shaded pedigree.

If such a book is considered as necessary at home, where there are comparatively few club members, how much more is it necessary to such a country as this, and what more profitable than when racing and horse breeding are the mainstay of the industry. If the book is taken advantage of, and kept up to date by the Society, what a valuable volume it will prove in years to come.

In Great Britain during 1928 the stalls money given out was £282,000 and £287,000 of this sum £24,350 was won by horses with shaded pedigrees managed to get their accounts up to date. It is estimated that about 6 per cent of the races and 2 per cent of the stakes were won by horses not clean bred.

SHORT WAVE TRANSMISSION.

A Brief Explanation.

The "E. A. Standard" has arranged for the regular publication of a wireless page. These articles, written by Mr. Lionel J. ...
 ...for medium waves have been considered. For the majority of listeners in Kenya Colony (which includes Uganda and Tanganyika) it is not possible to rely on what are called short waves, or to give them their proper term, High Frequency Transmissions. Receivers for these class of transmission do not vary in general principles from those used on the medium frequency bands, but in detail they vary considerably, and a fresh set of problems confront the designer and the user.

Before considering these receivers in detail it would be as well to try and give some popular ideas of what long and short waves are. High and low frequency mean. The average reader takes them as read simply because they represent an entirely new set of conditions and after all "Radio is Radio and what does it matter whether the waves are long or short?" However, it is as well to get some sort of general idea of what is actually happening.

It is a plain, a grand for performance, to be opposed and the strings attached it will be found that there is a vast difference between the glass and the face and the trouble end. ...the short wave stations vary from 10 to 20 meters (30 to 60 Kilometers) in length. At the extreme right hand end of the piano it will be noticed that the strings are very short and cannot be observed to vibrate at all. It does, however, at a very high rate, roughly about 400 cycles per second (that is 1 kilocycle). These correspond to the short waves or high frequency transmissions on the high radio, such as 10 to 30 meters.

The analogy the full scale of a piano and the full scale of radio waves does not hold in most cases. To begin with, the piano consists of some seven octaves whereas the useful range for radio is some eleven and a half octaves.
