Children's Holiday Camp

When, six years ago, the experiment was made of taking a number of European children from the Highlands for a communal holiday at Mombasa, it was such a success that almost immediately it should become an annual institution. There were some problems, however, which had to be solved before any scheme of a permanent nature could be embarked upon and these problems at the time seemed so difficult that it was doubtful if the holiday could ever become more than an occasional excursion dependent on the generosity of a few private individuals and the quality of the weather on any given day. With the splendid gift by Sir All bin Salim of three and a half acres on a flat situation on the mainland, the idea of an annual camp began to assume a definite shape. The plan for the establishment of the camp, tentatively put forward that year, was revived with vigour in 1929, the establishment of the first year sufficient funds had been collected to enable a start to be made on the clearing of the ground and the erection of temporary shelters. The arrangements in 1930, despite their somewhat Bohemian character were so much appreciated by the children who were able to take advantage of them, that the organizers appealed with confidence for further funds to enable the permanent camp to be constructed in time for the 1931 holiday season. Last year the main buildings were erected and everything possible was done to make the camp facilities as good as any not only enjoyed—but which children in almost any circumstances would derive from living on an unobscured spot—both health and comfort. The results were better than ever, the most popular of all the camps and the most healthy have been held. The large number of children who went to the seaside (children, be it remembered who ordinarily would not have been able to have this very desirable chance of the Highlands to the Coast) came back invigorated, mentally and physically and looking forward with the keenest anticipation to the following year's holiday.

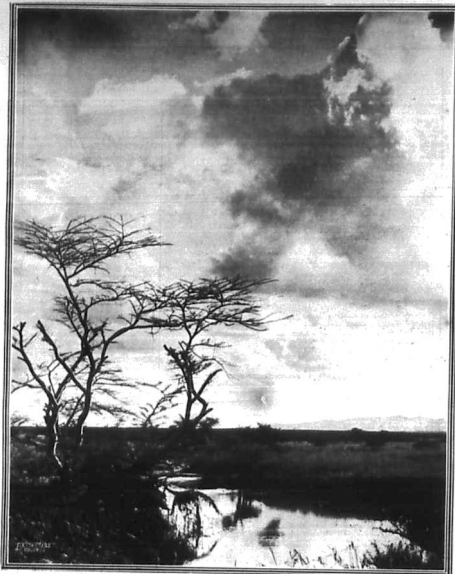

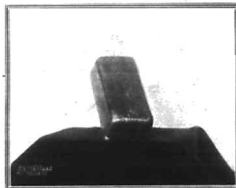

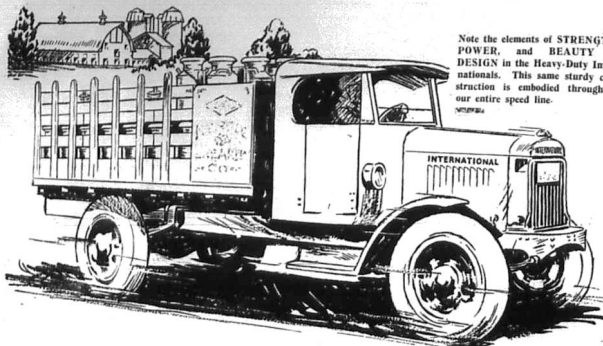

I think through their instrumentality certain teams and matches could be arranged for a combined golfing Society of Kenya, bringing under the aegis of the Kenya Golf Union.

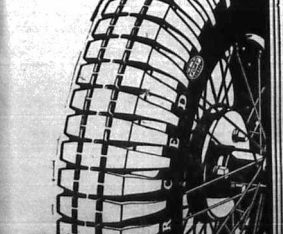
