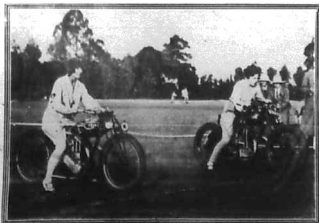

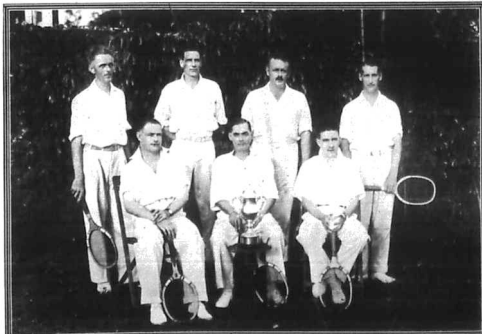

**MEMORANDUM PRESENTED.**
