Sir Samuel Wilson Stands By His Report

WHITE PAPER CRITICISED.

Dangers of Re-Opening the Kenya Indian Question.

The atmosphere and surroundings of the Joint Committee on the East African question are described in the "Standard" by Sir Samuel Wilson in an introductory passage to the first day's sitting when the evidence of Sir Samuel Wilson was taken.

If such a show—and the same applies to all entertainment in this small isolated spot on the map—is doing the very best, "don't do the picnic!" Nairobi is not a dramatic centre of international grade producing new comedies in plays and pictures for the reviewer to praise or deprecate. Evidently, during these necessary very short runs of pantomime, neither your nor mine has much effect, anyhow. 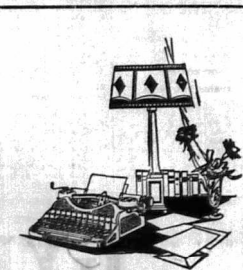

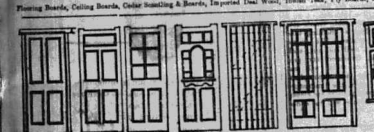

Natives' Villages are deserted and cattle are straying. The roads are in a state of chaos and burning. The rebels' presence is indicated by heavy smoke ascending from the depths of inaccessible jungles.
It is now estimated that the Lewis gunners of Palmyra killed one hundred of the five hundred attackers.

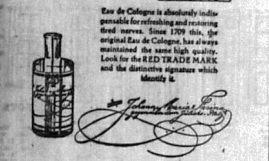

BRITISH TRADE WITH TANGANYIKA.

Decline in Share of Imports.

COMMONS STATEMENT

The decline in the United Kingdom's trade with Tanganyika is revealing the attitude of the Government in regard to the country in the House of Commons during last week. Mr. P. J. Hankey (Cons.), Ministry of Commerce, said that the value of the imports from Tanganyika in the year 1920 whether foreign trade with that territory had been increasing during the past six years, and if any effort is being made to secure an larger share as possible of this market for British goods?

Mr. J. M. Gilliat (Secretary for Foreign Trade) said the answer is a long one. I propose to have it divided into the Official Report, which is a most important point. WORLD'S CEREAL MARKET.

Steadying of Prices for Maize.

K.F.A. Report.

The following is the weekly market report of the Kenya Farmers Association Ltd., dated December 31—

Maize.

The grain trade in general tends to firmer prices and although there is no substantial increase in value, it is expected that for maize the price will remain steady and about Shs. 20/- per quarter. Argentine Yellow which is brought in higher than the white in all the regions of the Rift. Damuli and South Africa are showing in comparative small quantities which may account for the better demand for K.F.

The decision of the Government Board in permitting the importation of 100,000 tons of maize has been one of the factors leading to the steadying of prices. Hence, early in the month of thought in South Africa had the effect of pushing up prices and maize in bags at Johannesburg reached Shs. 12/-.

However, the position has changed due to rains later in the month. Looking into the future there is no doubt that the early planting in South Africa has resulted from want of rain and the exportable surplus next season will be considerably less than for this season and farmers are very nervous about the future.

Wheat.

The wheat position has somewhat changed owing to the alteration of policy of the Canadian Pool. The new manager has decided to show more tender new American in Paris and London and all through the usual channels. Wheat will not be held off the market as in the past, but will be sold regularly.

Rhodessa Mills, in order to encourage the local production of wheat, are guaranteeing, growers Shs. 20/- per 200 lbs. This will have some effect on our exportable surplus value as Rhodesia has been a regular purchaser from Kenya.

South Africa, by high protective

tariff and the necessity of a heavier tax would be a purchaser of our exportable surplus and we can now only look to Europe to take our surplus. Wheat values are about 70 cents above last week's quotation.

Barley.

The supplies of cheap local barley are mounting and local traders should fetch about Shs. 5/- per bag locally. The overseas value has slightly halved.

Oats.

Supplies of oats are plentiful locally at Shs. 7/- per bag for good quality.
