Co-operation Between The Two White Races.

"HELL LONG ENOUGH"

Republican Movement Among Nationalists Condemned.

South Africa has been shaken to its political foundations by striking speeches made by the Prime Minister, General Hertzog, since his return from the Imperial Conference.

Speaking at Pretoria a few weeks ago, the Premier denounced the Republican movement. He said that South Africa had won her freedom after a fight lasting 100 years.

He warned his supporters that if they wanted to make the Nationalist Party a Republic Party they would have to reckon with him. He denied having been a traitor to the cause of Nationalism and gave his party the choice of Nationalism and his policy of co-operation between British South Africans and Dutch South Africans.

The Premier's speeches have been widely welcomed, especially by General Smuts, leader of the S.A.P. who offers all support for such an aim—but he pointed out that on this occasion it is not mere words.

He recalled that in 1926, when General Hertzog reached the same doctrine, his declarations were followed in a few months by the Flag Campaign.

Mr. J. H. Hofmeyr, another prominent South African politician, while also urging for association with the Premier, suggests that in the past General Hertzog has never dragged a lever that is to-day dismayed by the crop of armed men wreaking havoc in the Union.

S.A.P. Offers Support.

On the occasion of a reception to him on December 10th by the Transvaal National Party, Mr. Prime Minister of South Africa, General Hertzog, speaking at Pretoria re-affirmed the policy which he had announced when he issued his Imperial Conference speech.

He said that he was not prepared to welcome any change in his speech. "I trust shall be pardoned if I say something which is other than what I would now say had I heard the speech," he said.

Due Mainly to Programme of Public Works.

AND HEAVY FALL IN SISAL.

Mineral Finds Likely to Change Rail Problem in S. West.

That the country has a deficit of over £350,000, chiefly due to expenditure on Public Works, was revealed by His Excellency Sir Donald Cameron in the course of an address to the Tanganyika Legislative Council.

His Excellency said the Territory had no money to devote to such purposes as a Land Bank and referring to a suggestion that the Government intended to build deep water berths at Tanga and Dar es Salaam, Sir Donald declared: "Government has no such policy proposal in contemplation."

The Governor made reference to recent mineral discoveries which in the future might have a considerable bearing on railway policy in the South West.

No Money For Land Bank.

Due to the heavy fall in sisal prices, the Government has a very poor financial year. Despite the low price the export of sisal had increased and his view was that the Government should do everything possible to assist the industry.

## TANGANYIKA'S DEFICIT OF £350,000.

(Continued from page 1.)  
Having regard to the phenomenal and disastrous fall of the tin market, had not been as bad as had been supposed, the country was faced with the enormous deficit of over £200,000, which £250,000 was represented by the Government as a programme of Public Works. Retrospectively having a deficit no more amount to be over £20,000.

**Transport Problems.**

Speaking of the provision of the Road, Sir Donald referred to the fact that in a despatch on the question he had expressed the opinion that conditions might alter considerably owing to mineral discoveries, particularly in the Tanga area.

**Importance of Coal.**  
Commenting upon this paragraph in his despatch, the Governor said "What is more important is that gradually increasing requirements for fuel will be met by the use of coal. An impression had been formed in certain quarters that the East African, that Government intended to build a steamship service at Tanga and Dar es Salaam. "The Tanganyika" said Sir Donald "has been asked to propose a steamship."

## THREE YEARS FOR COUNTERFEITING.

Justice Disagrees with Assessors.

AN APPEAL.

The man was found before His Honor Mr. Justice Shegama on Monday in which an Indian vendor of River Road, Nairobi, was charged with being in possession of moulds for the making of counterfeit coins and also with being in possession of a number of counterfeit coins (shillings).

Witnesses for the prosecution testified to having searched the premises of the accused, Maganlal Shankarshah, and found both the moulds and the counterfeit shillings.

For the defence, Mr. Schwartz sought to prove that the moulds and the coins had been "planted" in the premises of the accused by a Hindu named Mathradas, who had been named, but had not been seen since the search and his whereabouts were unknown.

Evidence was called by the defence to show that "second left" and returned to his shop at 7.0 a.m. on November 25. A Sub-Inspector of Police stated that although the search warrant was granted on November 17 it was not executed until the morning of November 20. On that day he went round to the Office of the Chief of Police, in charge of the Criminal Investigation Department at about 7.15 a.m. and told him that he thought that was the right time to search the premises. Evidence was also produced to the effect that one of the moulds contained the actual mould sold by another Indian at Mathradas.

**Assessors' View.**  
The three assessors expressed the opinion that accused was not guilty, but His Honor Mr. Justice Shegama did not agree with this view and sentenced accused to undergo three years' imprisonment.

Mr. Schwartz applied for bail for his client pending an appeal, and His Honor stated that he would give his decision at a point in Chamber.

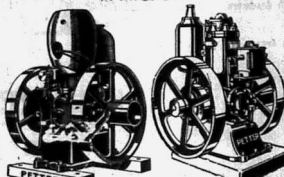

# FUTURE OF NAIROBI EUROPEAN HOSPITAL.

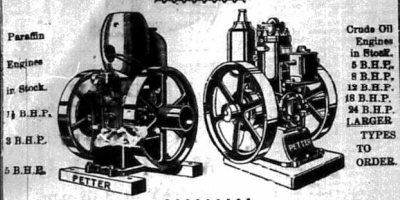



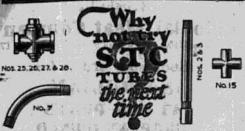
