Regarding the question of railway extension to the Congo, which a good deal of attention has been paid to in East Africa Standard, I find that Sir Walter de Vries, M.P., has been taking an interest in this matter, and he was good enough to place before me a letter which has been received from Dr. Drummond Shaw, M.P., Under Secretary of State for the Colonies, on the subject. The Shaw says: "I have now looked into the question of the extension of the main line of the Kenya and Uganda Railway from the point where you wrote to me on the 18th December. The position is that a scheme for an extension from Nairobi to a point on the Congo-Bahr-el Jebel River, has been submitted to the Secretary of State by the High Commissioner for East Africa and Uganda. No final decision has been taken regarding the completion of the extension, but it is not unlikely that work, and also of an alternative route to the north of the main line, will shortly be available at an early date for the first section to Malindi and, as soon as the route, together with detailed estimates of cost, are received, the matter will be further considered with a view to a definite application for financial assistance being made to the Colonial Development Advisory Committee."

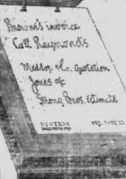

to all and particularly to the Governor and the Kabaka. He recalled that the first was built by the Kabaka two years ago and was grateful for the new scheme given by the Uganda and Nalubaale Railways. He was owing to the fact that the bridge was well and cheaply and at a cost of less than one million, a great popularity than any line in the part of Africa.

Mr. William Gervase spoke of the pleasure and privilege which he had looked forward to for years in travelling on the first railway across the bridge on the completion of the most important railway development since the railway reached Lake Victoria.

**Lord Pountney's Message.**

His Excellency read a message from the Secretary of State congratulating the Government on the completion of a valuable addition to the Imperial facilities of the Protectorate. He also read a message from the High Commissioner of Tanganyika.

Mr. William continuing said the extension was a triumph of economy and efficiency for departmental railway construction. He paid a tribute to all associated in the work mentioning Government officials and the Kabaka and his subjects. He said a special tribute to Mr. Binshi the Resident Engineer.

His Excellency said he would have been to have asked the Earl of Athlone and Princess Alice, also part of the ceremony but he hoped, he was able in thinking that the public would enjoy the benefits of the extension at the earliest possible moment. Thanks it had been opened today.

**The Next Aim.**

He agreed with the Governor of Kenya who in his capacity as High Commissioner of Tanganyika stated that he would not rest until the East Nile Railway reached the Congo.

Mr. William referred to the present acute and prolonged economic depression. The time of recovery was uncertain but they were consolidating the position regarding railway transport. These territories were most favourably placed to take full advantage of the improved conditions which must inevitably occur.

The Belgians Government and the Congo Government had shown themselves courteous and appreciative in their attitude towards the railway and road systems joining the Congo and Uganda and the Eastern Congo within the development of petroleum in the region of Lake Albert might prove as other potent factor in the development of the Western Valley. He was assured that when the road was completed the Congo border near Katesa a connection would be made by the Congo Government.

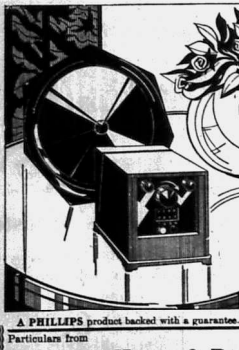

see how the money had vanished a few years ago.

As a result of certain questions and answers Mr. Henson had that no shares were issued for cash, and therefore, no outside capital was brought in until a year after the commencement of 1912.

**Mr's Estate Shares.**  
Dobson could not agree that Enjay Ltd. started owing him Shs. 90,000/100. He repeated for time to answer, and a signed receipt book was produced by Mr. Henson containing the name of the debtor then asked that an official receipt was appointed for Enjay Ltd. on July 8, 1907 by that date the company owed Mr. Henson Shs. 82,000/100. Shs. 55,000 of the difference were accounted for by the transfer of shares. These were Mr's Estate shares. It passed then over to Mr. Henson, and debited himself on January 8, 1909 with the price of the shares. Explaining this, he said he credited the Mr's Estate shares to Enjay's books with the amount.

The shares were 250 each. Enjay Ltd. said he owed Mr. Henson money. It was also Managing Director of Mr's Estate.

**Unreconciled Transactions.**

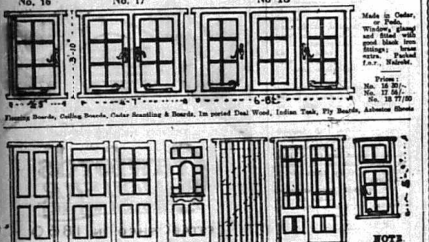

**PLAQUE OF FOG OVER LONDON.**

Interfers With the Christmas Spirit.

**ANXIOUS TEMPER.**

(Standard Correspondent.)  
London, Dec. 24

Christmas time this year has been chiefly remarkable for the smog which we have had in London. Throughout the whole week leading up to Christmas Eve there has been fog, thick yellow, which impeded the traffic back fog which has made the system, starting a flying and through area. In fact quite serious weather which makes us all very anxious and relations over seas who are probably banking in suspense.

Of course a little fog is rather a nuisance in London. It makes the shop windows more interesting at night and gives the city a certain mystery but so much fog as we have had this year has scarcely been a nuisance. For those who live in the suburbs and have to get out to them about their day's work in London it has been a most troublesome time. Buses have had to proceed at walking pace with someone going in front with a lantern. Trains have been delayed and there have been unprecedented traffic blocks all over the West-end of London because an enormous number of people have been trying to get up there to do last-minute shopping.

It seems that nothing can be invented which can enable fog to penetrate fog and more than any other source of atmospheric pollution. Nevertheless, Americans are powerless against it and that is the reason why they had very heavy losses in Paris for the Christmas season. It has also meant a bad time for the Theatre especially those in the outlying districts because no one has been able to get at them.

**Royal Christmas.**

The Royal Family are spending Christmas as they usually do at Sandringham and the Prince of Wales will be there too. One of the King's Christmas presents will be a gift containing four-and-twenty woodcock from the Governor-General of the Irish Free State. The custom has been to give

ever since 1815 when Lord Talbot, Government Minister, presented such a gift to George III.

**Political Outlook.**

It will be an uneasy Christmas for politicians. The outlook for the Irish Republic is not considered encouraging and Mr. Henry Macdonnell will not be able as a result to spend Christmas in the native Scotland. The production of the Trade Disputes Bill and the suggestion of the change in the law have also made it quite on the cards that there will be a General Election very soon after the Christmas recesses.

People have not been giving presents on the same generous scale as usual and people like dentists and opticians who go round asking for Christmas Buses are anticipating a very thin year. The big stores all report that their customers have not bought so freely as usual. The Tourist Companies have also feared that they will not be so successful. It has been stated by an official of one Company that they have not had as had a year their War. The trains leaving Switzerland have many more been than the old ones. All this can be tried to the slump in prices and the fall in prices of stocks and dividends.

The divergence is being kept in the streets. It will be a long time before Christmas is really so merry as many who doubt it and who think we have little to do with Christmas as we reach round our fires in this fog-bound city.



At a special sitting of the Kenya Legislative Council, today, a motion will be introduced providing for a loan out of surplus bonds and asks free of interest to the maize industry.

At a meeting of the Empire Association today a resolution was passed recommending the President's attitude regarding the Round Table Conference.

Constantinople, January 15. The authorities here, it is believed, have shown that the reactionary government in Syria was included to overthrow the present democratic regime and supplant it by a theocratic one based on the Sharia and Khalifa.

It is as likely, the Miners' Delegate Conference at Cardiff to-day accepts the provisional agreement reached by owners and miners for the settlement of the South Wales dispute there it likely to be peace in the coal fields for at least three years.

Government could only help by obtaining necessary marketing facilities and to place that matter in a position to be able to meet the necessary means at reasonable terms so as to enable him to avail himself of the marketing opportunities.

losses in agriculture out of the Treasury under prevailing conditions or even to guarantee him against loss, was able. It simply comes to this.

When agriculture could no longer be maintained on the present basis and its existence became dependent on assistance from the Treasury, it would be desirable and nobody would be able to see it.

**Government's Part.**  
The attraction of the farmer was to be sought after other lines, he added. "As has already been pointed out when the Government has helped the farmer to obtain the necessary marketing facilities, and has placed him in a position to be able to obtain the necessary means of reasonable terms to enable him to avail themselves of the marketing opportunities which are offered, then it has done as much as can reasonably be expected from a Government in the way of financial assistance."

**The Imperial Conference.**

In almost every agricultural country the great problem of the government today is how to assist its farmers to obtain the requisite correct market. So much is the case that it is the endeavor to find a solution to this problem, which is at the bottom of the movement, not to bring about economic union among the Empire states, and which in the same way was at the root of the insistence on the side of the Dominions at the recent Imperial Conference on the expansion of trade relations with the Commonwealth based on agreement and preferential tariffs.

**Britain and Preference.**

"As regards the extension of preferential tariffs in the British

market, in order that South Africa and the other Dominions may have a greater margin than Great Britain for their exports, there is not as yet any likelihood of change in the British market.

As long as the people of Great Britain remain wedded to Free Trade, without realizing the advantages of tariff discrimination in favour of the Dominion, it will not be possible to secure the present situation. Government told us in plain language that it has no intention of extending any preference to the Dominions, and that it will not allow Great Britain's trade with foreign countries to be detrimentally affected, by tariff, as the Dominions request.

"For these reasons the British Government would not appear to us with any kind of the other Dominions to assist one farmer to obtain greater marketing facilities by means of preferential tariffs."

"To us and also to Canada, Australia and New Zealand, it is clear that only by a system of tariff preferences would it be possible for our farmers to obtain any particular advantage on the English market in comparison with foreign countries. Some time before the meeting of the Conference we were acquainted with the economic policy of the British Government, and their attitude at the Conference in regard to this question was, therefore, not unexpected."

**Other Remarks.**

The seriousness of the matter from our point of view was made perfectly clear to the Conference, not only by the British and the other Dominions. It must be clear to everyone that unless South Africa can find a wider market for her products within the British Empire is a reasonable space of time her economic policy in regard to Commonwealth preferences will have to undergo considerable revision, which in the event of the abolition of the existing preference for our products on the English market, will in all probability have to be fundamental.

"Since our arrival in Bloemfontein, the critical condition of agriculture in the Free State has been submitted to me and to my colleagues. We shall give every assistance possible where we can do so to a sound economic basis. But in the name of the people of South Africa I pray factors not to expect the Government to assist them where assistance would be likely to do them harm, or assist them to their ruin."
