Tanganyika Council Bids Farewell to its President.

The meeting of the Tanganyika Legislative Council on Friday, members of the Council bade farewell to the Governor, Sir Donald Cameron, who is shortly leaving the territory for Nigeria. A motion recording appreciation of his distinguished services to the country, regret at his departure, and best wishes for his future, was moved by the leader of the Opposition, Mr. Donald Baid.

Replying Sir Donald said that the work of the past six years would endure in the hearts and minds of the African population, and the work achieved in various fields was already influencing and would continue to influence the history of East Africa.

It was announced in Council that the Canadian Government had decided to extend preferential tariffs to imports from Tanganyika.

A system of road tolls is being introduced in Tanganyika with a view to meeting unfair competition of road transport against railway.

MIDGHT GOLF COURSE REMOVED.

The Kenya Police at Eldoret have had to deal with many curious and unusual enquiries. But they are at present engaged on the investigation of what appears to be one of the most extraordinary happenings that has ever come under their notice, namely the disappearance of a Midgait Golf outfit.

It appears that Mr. Boyle who has recently been running Midgait Golf, for the amusement of people in Nairobi, at the Lyric Hotel showed up the premises on January 5 and left on the same day for Mombasa. He had arranged to sell the whole outfit to another party, and, having returned to Nairobi, went along to the Lyric Hotel on Saturday morning to hand it over and to complete the transaction. He was amazed to find that in fact there was no Midgait Golf Course to hand over!

Careful questioning of the native who had been left in charge of the outfit led him to state the information that a few days ago two natives arrived at the Hotel with a motor wagon. They furnished a letter in front of the manager, telling him, it is alleged, that they knew had used them to remove the "vile machine you pull". The letter was not handed over but the natives promised to give it to the manager later.

The natives then loaded on to the wagon the Midgait Golf Course, consisting of 22 platforms, with an net long by two feet wide. The platforms are constructed of wood, canvas and rubber. The wooden handles, oil and pull chains had been looked over elsewhere in the building and these were not interfered with.

The Police and the Criminal Investigation Department are making enquiries and the Kenya standards at the Lyric Hotel is of the opinion that he can recognize the natives that came with the motor wagon.

The present position is that the Midgait Golf Course has simply disappeared and no trace of the whereabouts has been discovered.

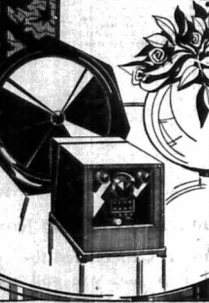

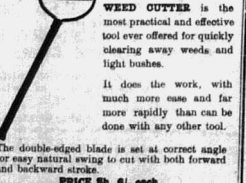

JANUARY 30TH.
Lewy had it set above a sad song on which to start up the ladder of fame. Jack Francis Miller, who died on this day in 1875, was surely a striking example of this. unknown in Kenya, the Board strongly recommended that the Chief Veterinary Officer be vested with powers of requisitioning and to inspect all cattle on arrival and to designate infested areas.

In this respect we have the advice and the cooperation of other African Colonies whose examples the Board is of the opinion it is well to follow.

Co-operative Agency.

An application by the residents of Thomson's Falls for a loan from the Colonial Development Fund for the erection of a Co-operative Store in that area has been submitted to the Board and endorsed by it.

A request has been received from the Kenya Farmers' Association that the Board should call that area to nominate special produce—those which have been considered by the Board. Whether this will be possible depends upon the question of export. The need for economy at the present time is imperative and the cost of such a visit would be considerable.

A number of minor matters have arisen and since from day to day for considerations either from the Department or otherwise, but the larger questions under investigation at the moment are Agricultural Credits and the wide subject of the means of promoting more mixed farming.

In this connection it is hoped to publish in a later stage reports of the various farming programmes suitable to the financial and climatic conditions of Kenya with practicable tables of expenditure and returns and embodying the market conditions of the commodities concerned.

In particular an investigation is being conducted with a view to finding means of marketing the products on a large and stable basis. A considerable amount of data has already been collected and the magnificent libraries conducted in the matter indicate a reasonably prospect that important developments may be expected in the shape of organized marketing facilities for a substantial output provided part of the highly specialized quality required for export can be produced in Kenya.

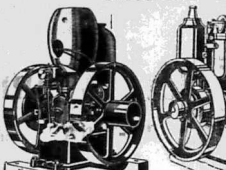

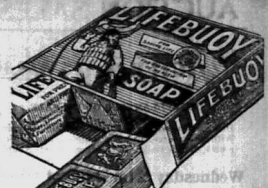

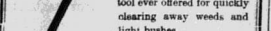

As a poultry breeder of a good many years' experience, I read with some interest the various letters that have lately appeared in your valuable paper...

If I do as in some letters, male birds are not to be sent to make up the pen after the eggs from such matings to be sold as fittings, half of such sent going to the owner of the pen and half to the Laying Farm.

I may state I have given the salary of the Manager as Shs. 7000 for the year, but as he is a very good man, I think, when one takes into consideration that he would be a responsible position for seven whole days per week and daily for the year, therefore I should like to see at least two unpaid weeks per year attached, so these would do a certain amount of the trap setting and so on.

with any hope of profit will be to have them collected, graded and packed by co-operation among the exporters. This has been mentioned in some of the letters...

During the time the eggs are shipped from the pen they are derived from the side of the nest...

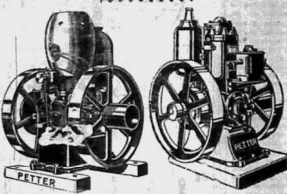

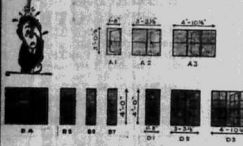
