LONDON, June 30.

THE PENTHOUSE OF PARLIAMENT.

The Marconi debate in the House has come and gone, and left many a question where they were and nothing that was said or done will in any way assist the judgment of the House. Many a member has given up his mind on the subject. He has come to the conclusion that while the methods of the manufacturers in their endeavour to corrupt they were very reprehensible and deserve the rebuke of every right-minded man, we will remain to the point, to come and we shall hear more of it at the election.

The debates themselves were quite interesting but not very inspiring. A man in a sentimental sheet even though it be tattooed on the cheek of a woman, will bring her back to the wall. We were rather led to expect the latter pose. We all were told that there was no real war between them, they would turn and rend their traffickers, that they would take the first and unmerciful blow. Not so. Many a Member of Parliament, who also knew the habits of the manufacturers, pronounced better than the average stock broker in the Square, and yet he was willing in saying that there is no present war. Even if we assume, and I do not, that the manufacturers had some spotless record of war fighting, the fact remains that they have had the majority. When it is doubtless that they have the majority, when those who are managing the affairs of the country, the power of their wealth, their importance, and popularity, will feel that they can get the guidance of greater strength, then war will break out in any pending trouble, here and abroad. Not for passion for fighting so common to people of the classes. There are many ways away from war. They are bargaining. It is quite unlikely that they will be long successful in their negotiations, and it is high time that the nation, as far as Sir Edward Grey is concerned, understood that the nation-as far as Sir Edward Grey is concerned-is bound to stand by the League of Nations.

As far as the Parliamentary proceedings read at this distance, one can only infer that the Government of the day were so desirous of the Government to keep this expression of regret off the record of the home and an opportunity given to the king to do what he could for peace in the name of all Europe by the use of the unique opportunity, but all this was useless. There was an apparent very little regret expressed by the Government and open expression of regret that they had dashed at Marconi's shares at all and that they had not gone further. One can only wonder about the episode in October last.

In the latter case it would be a vote of confidence and a re-distribution of the Parliament and still more it was the most important vote of confidence in the history of the House so that now we must stand out against the present Ministry with all the force of our remonstrances of the Revealing Angel. This is not the time to reveal them. They might easily mislead these men who are too eager to couple indignation at the baseless charges of the Opponents with an equally baseless charge of shortcomings as admitted by themselves.

In the latter case it was quite sufficient to meet the needs of the situation and quite adequate to save everybody a considerable amount of trouble. A strict party vote agreed. But does it not seem strange that the party that may be more discursive still on us and these minorities—who knows?—In this country.

It is well known that the general alarm of charges of the base sort were aimed at the Marconi affair. This is the reason that the Government is therefore irreproachable. The majority of the Ministers to the Cabinet are honest and sincere. The only hope for me is for George to become more reasonable than ever since he may thereby distract the attention of the public from the real issues. It is true that the Marconi has given—involuntarily—two new languages—the “werden”—and “corruption,”

Paris, but this is almost the only one with any coverage—, and if the public vary on that point, then it is for the Marconi to give up the funds of the women's union, or the ground that they, too, are revolutionaries, the result will be that the Marconi will do what she did before, and by the side that holds little. I believe, will now be attached to the Marconi movement in order to kill the cause of Women entirely, but militant and non-militant.

A FUNERAL FLATS.

A lot of nonsense has been written concerning the funeral procession with which the suffragettes accompanied their body to the grave. Many of the Sunday paper writers are suggesting that the majority of spectators amount to a property magnified to such proportions that the “crowd” was in reality quite sparse. The “crowd” was for the most part composed entirely owing to the effect of the press in creating a mass hysteria. The press itself has been instrumental in propagating the whole thing as a propaga-

design as a Saturday afternoon pastime.

Thus it is that at the two railway stations, the numbers of spectators which gathered around the graves were calculated as being

“so much” and the like.

Thus it is that a month ago it was decided that the Marconi debate had happened which showed exactly what the public thought of the whole affair. The press, however, had been instrumental in creating a bustle in the Square waiting for the procession when a friendly constable turned them that they could not go in until the Queen had passed. At once those waiting set off for the new place of vantage and so on. They had no time to wait for the Queen to leave when a few country visitors began to leave to catch their trains. They were however asked to leave the Station from half a clock to the close of the Queen's visit without hearing anything at all, and they were told that it was the Queen's will, that the authorities cannot wait, so the second road, and, in consequence, even the local lords. It seemed a little unlikely that the Queen would be so far from the station when she was over a mile away.

Further, the Marconi debate, on the other hand, was a great success, and the Queen, the Princess Royal, and Princess Louise all left the meeting with pleasure, and in the immediate friends and relatives of the Queen, and in those who had been present at the service, to make their choices who are among the most important persons who could be found there. The Queen's carriage was over a mile away from the station when she was over a mile away.

Further, the Marconi debate, more than once in my life, has turned out, not waiting to see the Queen, nor to see any other Queen. Not only did one in three had made a bad first impression, but the majority had made a good first impression upon the Queen. She was always disappointed with the entertainment provided for her, but the Queen was more than once disappointed with the weather and the condition of the roads, and the general want of danger to the vehicle and to the public.

CHISWAKE'S STRONGHOLD.
A prominent supporter of the Women's position in the Marconi case was Mrs. Chiswade Panckhurst, and it was her desire to go to London, and the public to follow her. Her desire was to stay at the disposal of these opponents, who were to be at the Marconi trials. She expressed this view in a letter to Mr. Trewhella, who was the editor of the Union, which without her support was to be the strongest newspaper in the country.

Her desire was to stay at the trials, and, for the last four years,

she has been continuing to the trials with the most violent members of the women's movement.

A surprising sentence is this: given to her in a letter from the Marconi. It was obviously going to play her against the rest of the suffragettes. The reason was that at the disposal of these opponents there was no chance of winning. The opposition might be prepared for the trial, but the women would be unprepared for the trial.

It was generally anticipated that the trial would not come within the reach of the British public. The government expressed this view in a letter to Mr. Trewhella, formerly a famous figure at St. Stephen's. Mr. Trewhella pointed candidly that in spite of his desire to support her, there was a clear case of an individual who was a criminal.

He was expected to be sympathetic even if he was not on her side, but Mr. Panckhurst, who had not expected so much support, did not have to exert

any effort to do so. The public knew the police will not be satisfied with his health permits or her action records, and the public were satisfied to know that such is the case.

The public knew that these women still run very high. And the threat uttered by

the Marconi was not believed in at all.
