UGANDA COTTON NEARS PRODUCTION LIMIT.

Private Discussions of an Alternative Product.

Agicultural prospects in Uganda was one of the subjects discussed during the debate on the Railway Estimates, the speaker being the Director of Agriculture who replied to the criticism repeated by an Opposition Member that Parliament neglected the interests of the Buganda Province.

The Director thinks that greater cotton production by natives will come about more or less naturally without any drastic steps to encourage it.

Generally the cotton-growing possibilities of Uganda under the present system are, according to the Director, "very close to saturation."

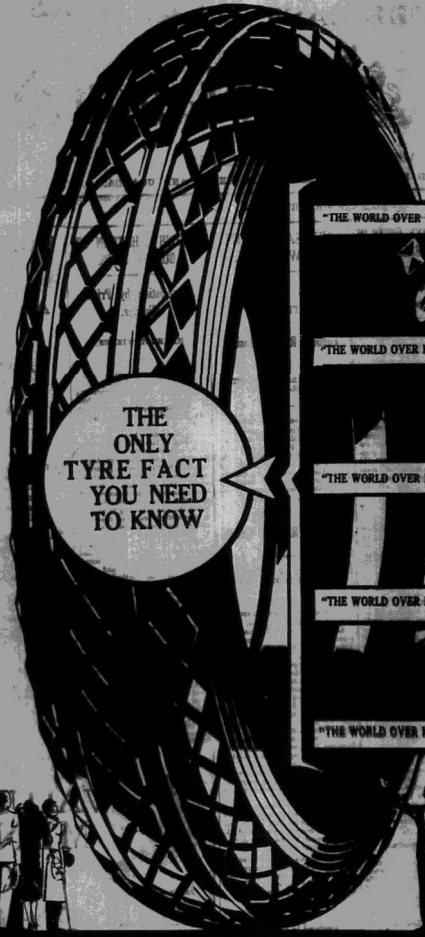
The Advisory Board has considered many of the problems arising under the Ordinance and made some recommendations to Government.

It is considered that certain amendments might be made to the Ordinance, whether a control by license of Mills should be introduced and applications showing need for new Mills be submitted by a Licensing Authority before their erection is allowed.

One of the objections of the Ordinance is to ensure that all wheat has a proportion of its own surplus to be sold to the Ordinance.

Payment to growers has been made for all wheat supplied to mills. (Continued on page 5.)

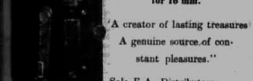

WORKING OF THE WHEAT BOOL.

(Continued from page 1).

Under the Ordinance and the details thereof about through want of proper means of sale came in the future no payment will be made until fortnight.

The question of increasing the initial payment has been considered by the Advisory Board on two occasions. This amount will be increased if it is found that the exportable surplus is not likely to be increased. It is usual to have a band that on the Overseas market to-day when it is worth less than maize and any quantity of wheat exported will have the effect of considerably reducing the final amount for distribution.

Coast Competition.

Rumour and Australian being enjoying two months' unaffiliated very liberally at Dar es Salaam, Tanga and Mombasa where, in the past, considerable quantities of Kenya flour and atta have been sold. In order to meet the competition from outside flour and atta a system of control has been found so that while pay less for the wheat used in manufacturing flour sold at these points. This system of control will, it is hoped, enable the mills to maintain their output and keep the exportable surplus of wheat as low as possible.

The Official 'Crop Report' for December estimates the Wheat Crop at 212,000 bags. The Advisory Board are of the opinion that this is too high an estimate, but until more returns have been received from growers, it is impossible to know the true total.

Within a month the quantity of wheat in the Colony should be known fairly accurately.

The Advisory Board has recommended that the loss through non-fulfilling of the Coast on error which should be borne by the growers of wheat only on wheat containing 15 per cent. and over of moisture, between 13 per cent. and 15 per cent., the loss to be borne by the pool.

The necessity for the prohibition of wheat and four importation is not being lost sight of and the Advisory Board have this matter in hand.

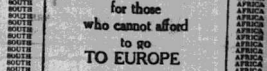

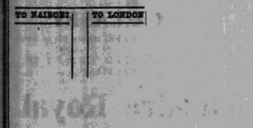
