PROBLEMS OF THE DAIRY INDUSTRY.

Discussed by Leading Kenya Dairymen. FACTORS IN SUCCESS.

East African Standard' Tour of The Stock-farming Districts.

general agreement among all who are acquainted with the economic conditions of Kenya, the Dairy Industry is recognised as one of the sections of farming activity in the Colony passing through the present period of trial without serious strain. Indeed, on the contrary, the Dairy Industry is steadily improving its position.

It is recognised, further, that in the future the Dairy Industry will and must play an increasingly important part in the readjustment of agricultural ideas, more particularly in the direction of mixed farming, with which is closely related increased white settlement, development of the minor forms of industry, an increase in variety of export trade, and the more complete utilisation of the land resources of the Colony in smaller economic units.

Like almost all other branches of industry in the country Dairy Farming is still in the experimental stage. But Kenya happily possesses a number of dairymen whose methods have been attended by steady success and the "East African Standard" believes that, at the present stage, those engaged in the industry could, with profit, consider and discuss fundamental problems in their relation to the principles which are applied to these problems by men well-known throughout the country.

In the present moment, therefore, a staff representative of the "East African Standard" is engaged in a tour of some of the main dairy districts. He will interview a number of representative dairymen and their views on dairy problems will be published in series of special articles.

To open up the subject, the "East African Standard" appoints Captain F. O'B. Wilson of Ulu (one of Kenya's best known pioneer dairymen) who has contributed the foundation article of the series published below.

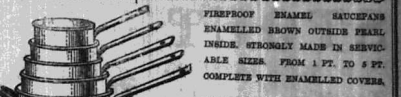

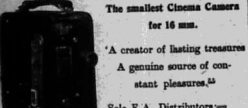

**ASSISTANCE TO SISAL INDUSTRY.**

**Recommendations by the Committee.**

**\$75,000 LOAN PROPOSED.**

**For Maintenance and Rotation at Sh. 1/50 per Acre per Month.**

The Committee appointed by Government to enquire into the present state of the coffee and sisal industries has presented a voluminous report on the prevailing conditions in the sisal industry and has made recommendations for the assistance of growers during the existing critical period.

The Committee in the course of its report refers to the large increase in production of sisal since 1898. It adds that there is no question of the suitability of the Colony for the growing of sisal, and there are still vast areas untouched.

Costs of production have been reduced late and the Committee is confident that growers are making every effort to bring costs to their lowest level.

As a result of these inquiries and other investigations, the Committee recommends that a sum of £75,000 be provided under the Agricultural Advances Ordinance, to assist individual growers on the basis of Sh. 1/50 per month per acre per month to be applied to maintenance and rotation planting.

**A Temporary Depression.**

The Committee proposed to provide into the present state of the coffee and sisal industries a sum of £75,000 to be made available under the Agricultural Advances Ordinance for assistance to the sisal industry.

Progress of the Industry. In the year 1897-98 there was a total area of 50,000 acres planted with sisal in Kenya Colony and 5,124 in the other territories.

like one of the Colony's surplus balances, and considered that this should be done by him. The factors of the Colony he went on, depended on improved settlements, and he warned his hearers that in their anxiety to increase the settlements it must not be done by increasing a potential poor white population. It should be done by getting a sufficient of the immigrants here to settle in this direction. Two ways, in his opinion, to attract people (1) by the abolition of the Death Duties, coupled with the fact that there was no Income Tax, and (2) proper publicity at home. He suggested that a publicity office should be attached to the East African office.

Turning to a more or less special matter, the European hospital at Nairobi, the speaker said the hospital had to be put into proper condition, with a maternity and children's ward, and a section by which people could go down at reduced charges. In this connection he paid a tribute to the untiring interest and boundless enthusiasm displayed by Mr. D. Newmark. Presently, he (the speaker) believed in a continued hospital. Another important point for the future to be taken up was the road transport rail competition. A committee had been appointed and was now making evidence.

A further matter of importance was extended credit. He believed the so-called high cost of living in Nairobi was not high costs at all, it was the high standard which was brought about to a large extent by extended credit. For the benefit of the community the right thing was to curb for everything all the time.

**The Civil Service.**  
Capt. Schwabe informed the meeting that a Commission would shortly be appointed to go into the question of the Civil Service, and he thought it was rather pointing the start before the house that the Elected Members having asked the Commission should then begin make a series of suggestions in view of evidence now taken. He argued that different conditions had to apply to new entrants to the Service, but said that the contractual obligations of the present members had to be respected when making a new law, however, nothing contradictory to treatment of travelling allowances.

For this reason the Government had appointed a committee, which had begun the afternoon to deal with these questions. The committee would report within a fortnight, because it had been asked to report at the earliest possible moment so that they might get down to a possible revision of these allowances, which, as far as travelling allowances were concerned, were original and non-negotiable.

**Questions.**  
In conclusion, Capt. Schwabe urged that his hearers should not be too pessimistic. He had never wavered in his belief for the future of the Colony, and he believed that most people were determined to see the colony through its difficulties.

Questions were invited, and in the course of the discussion that followed, Mr. D. Newmark reminded Capt. Schwabe of the cable that the former resolution which had been endorsed by Sir Samuel Wilson some time ago, and asked whether he thought that Chamber could go back on a resolution that had already been agreed to and had submitted to the Government. The resolution was, in fact, a resolution that was diametrically opposed to the former resolution which had been endorsed by Sir Samuel Wilson, Mr. H. H. Young, Lord Lugard, and many other people.

Mr. J. Morrison disagreed with the abolition of death duties on the ground that too much attention was being paid and too much production being given to capital, while Mr. J. Dobson, Hon. Secretary of the Association, replied that a Land Tax would be an exceedingly good thing for the country.

Capt. Schwabe, replying to Mr. Newmark, said that the action of one constituent member in voting down the resolution that the whole had voted for and carried unanimously was a precedent that would not be allowed to stand without protest. He advised that the original resolution of Mr. Chamberlain was contained in their telegram to Sir Samuel Wilson, but that it was pointed out that times had changed and that the question now was very different. Actually, at that informal meeting in Mombasa there was not complete unanimity. The meeting closed with thanks to the speaker for his address.

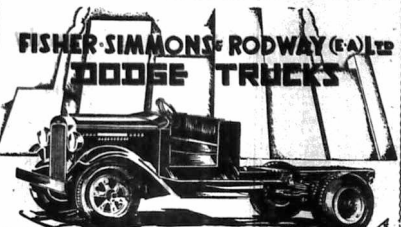

# PROBLEMS OF THE KENYA DAIRY INDUSTRY.

## The Experience and Practice of a Town Supplier.

### CONCENTRATION ON BREED.

#### An Opponent of "Ranching" Methods in the Colony.

The second article on the problems of the Dairy Industry, written by a staff representative of the "East African Standard" now on a tour of the dairy districts, is an interview with Mr. J. K. Watson, "Doonham" Dairy, near Nairobi.

Mr. Watson has a special aspect of the industry—the practice of a dairymen whose business is to supply milk to the town markets with fresh milk delivered daily.

#### No. 2: A Nairobi Dairy.

The problem surrounding the dairy industry grows deeper as we proceed to the source of stock. Perhaps the most serious difficulty is the production of better and viable specimens of stock.
