THE PROBLEMS OF THE DAIRY INDUSTRY

A Herd Built Up From Four Purchased Beasts TWO ESSENTIALS

Unremitting Supervision and High Production.

Having only bought four animals, Mr. H. St. J. Ayrre of Limeru has to-day 69 head of cattle. With the exception of his four purchases, every animal he owns has been bred on his own farm.

He has been 23 years stockbreeding and dairying in Kenya and his small Limeru property is modelled on New Zealand.

High milk yields are the reward of his work. The leading principles which have led him to success were discussed by him with a special correspondent of the "East African Standard" during his present tour of dairy districts.

He believes in stating his convictions quite frankly, whether they agree with, or differ from, those of a foundation, or the neglect of their daily work by some people who call themselves dairy farmers.

No. 3: A Limeru Dairy.

(By H. St. J. Ayrre, Limeru, in an interview with the "East African Standard.")

In the opinion of Mr. H. St. J. Ayrre, one of the most important points before the dairy farmer in Kenya today are (1) the necessity for many of the dairy farmers to get older down to their own business; (2) for the Limeru proprietor to be obtained with the best possible results, and (3) for the dairy farmer to be able to sell his milk at a profit. It is in the opinion of Mr. Ayrre that the dairy farmer should be able to sell his milk at a profit of 10 per cent. to 15 per cent. on the cost of the milk.

The Land and the Herd.

It is essential, in Mr. Ayrre's opinion, to have a good herd of cows. He is impressed so much by the fact that he has to pay for the cost of the milk, and that the milk is sold at a price which is not high enough to cover the cost of the milk.

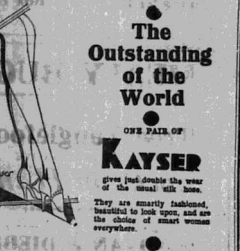

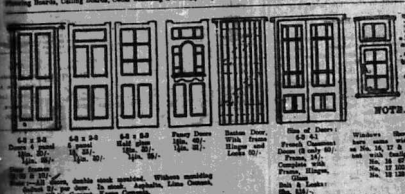

NEED FOR ENQUIRY INTO RAILWAY'S WORKING. Urged by the Convention of Associations.

FINANCIAL CRISIS. Suggestions for Cutting Down Running Costs.

The need for an investigation into the administration and work of the Kenya and Uganda Railways and Harbours system with a view to effecting economies and bringing about improvements was stressed by the Convention of Associations.

One of the principal speakers in the debate referred to Government financial estimates which have been characterized by a rashness entirely unsupported by common sense and foresight.

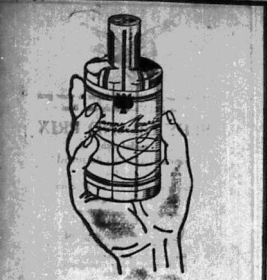

**"UNPARALLELED ERRORS IN FINANCIAL REPORT."**

**Unparalled Reflection on Europeans.**

**CALL FOR CORRECTION**

The 4th Convention represents its indignation at certain unparalled errors which appear in the annual statement contained in the report of the Judicial Department for 1920 and repeats that these errors have not been mentioned in the presentation of the report, which in these present circumstances is considered to convey an unwarranted reflection on the European population of the Colony. Further this Convention should be framed in such a way as to demonstrate that in every respect of the report in every particular, the members of the Convention should avoid confusion between the number of convictions with the number of persons convicted.

In moving a resolution, drafted on these lines, but of which the wording was subsequently amended to give greater force to the text, as in the above resolution, Mr. C. Kennedy Amber (P.O. Box 747, NAIROBI) stated that the main object of the Convention was the preservation of the report was that its first step was to be a complete reconstruction as to the actuality of the 4th European session of the Colony. The matter had been brought to their attention by the Editor of "East Africa."

It was only fair to state that if the report was read from beginning to end, there would be no misconception, but the ordinary man did not do this. As it was, there was very likelihood of the mistake committed of being taken away from their text. When this happened it brought an extreme change to the Colony. In the report some members of the Convention had been charged against about 18 per cent of the European population and about 14 per cent of convictions during the year 1920. When one came to read Section 25 of the report, which dealt with the most of offences, one found that Europeans were a much more numerous community per capita than the rest of the country, as compared

with colored races. Section 25 stated that out of a total of 20,000 persons held by the courts, 1,077 Europeans, 2,027 Asiatics and 25,775 natives were convicted with the aid of 150,000 hours of labor.
