The Court of Enquiry which was appointed to investigate the cause of the terrible disaster to the airship R101, which left Capetown on her maiden voyage to India on October 4, and crashed near Beauvais in France during the night, has issued its report. The oral evidence given by witnesses was amplified by intricate, technical experiments.

The Court states that the main causes of the disaster were over-anxiety to start the flight after insufficient preparation, and the substantial loss of gas in the very humpy weather.

Alternative Crops.

POSSIBILITIES OF BEANS FOR MAIZE-GROWERS.

The possibilities of an alternative crop for maize growers are mentioned in the following notes issued by the Department of Agriculture on White Highlands and Madagadcar Native Reserves.
 Farmers in maize-growing areas are reminded of the possibilities of beans such as the White Haricot and the Madagadcar Native Bean. These beans are known to grow in many parts of the Highlands and there is a steady market for alternative crops. Beans are one of the most profitable crops in the region, and the quality of the product is, however, of the first importance in selling such a crop and in order to secure a good price care must be taken in the sowing and grading of the seed. A single measurement to London must not be less than 10 lbs in weight. White Haricot beans are considered the most profitable of the small beans in this Colony.

Report Traffic.

THE COST OF LIVING IN FEBRUARY.

Meat, Fish and Cheese Chapter.

OFFICIAL BULLETIN.

A further slight decrease in the cost of living is shown in the bulletin for February issued by the Government Statisticians. The bulletin is as follows:-

During February 1911, the general price level of food and stores dropped still further—0.6 per cent on the whole, as compared with the same year 1910. The new price level (1911) was 107.1, and 0.6 per cent below the price level of 107.7 which was established in the January Bulletin. Two out of three items are now calculated, one comparative with those issued since 1907, and which the figure of the cost of living Commission was based, and the other calculated on the January 1906. The former shows selected articles while the latter includes information from all available sources.

The average index number based on returns from selected districts has dropped from 105.5 in 1909 (the year in which the Cost of Living Commission reported) to 97.7 in January 1911 and 82.2 in February 1911. The value for 1909 was 100. The average for 1910 January was 84.6, dropped to 80.6 in February 1910, to 87.7 in February 1911.

Chapter Meat and Fish.

The only important change is a drop of 6 per cent in the average price of meat and fish, and of 7 per cent in that of cheese. The other changes are of minor importance and refer to particular shops, but are no indication of change in price level.

The table showing the difference between the index price for meat and fish is again published in this month. The percentage change of the credit price from the retail price from all returns sent in for each city is as follows:-
