UGANDA FACING BIG REVENUE DROP.

Expected Total Shortage of £265,000.

ECONOMY PROPOSALS.

Future Plans to be Discussed with Public Representatives.

The Uganda Government anticipates that during 1951, the Revenue estimated when the Budget was prepared, will fall by another £24,000 making a total shortage of £265,000.

The Government submitted its proposals to the Executive Members of the Legislative Council.

In addition, the Government proposes to formulate a policy for 1952 and onwards and will do so with the assistance of a Special Committee which will include public representatives.

In the P.M.W. the works programme has been reduced by £119,290 and £100,000 of road work will be transferred to loans.

Motor allowances have been drastically reduced, privileges extended to officers going home by the Bill have been suspended and the practice of paying fees for officers taking local leave in Kenya has been abolished.

It is proposed to abolish the land of the 4th K.A.B. which costs the Protectorate £2,000.

Balancing the Budget.

Revenue Mustered = £150,000. This leaves a further £115,000 to be made, and it is expected to include in the Uganda public works bill a provision to cover the total expenditure on the Uganda Public Works Act estimated at £265,000. It is expected to include £150,000 to be advanced to the Government, on up to 1930, approximately £104,000 have been granted on the Western Frontier Roads. This is only carrying out an earlier estimate as funds were provided for this work from Surplus Taxation only as a temporary expedient to finance the work.

The annual cost is £200,000, and it is a little difficult to justify such a large expenditure, upon that cannot be regarded in terms of financial strategy, as an investment which the public may feel that if the Government could be satisfactorily satisfied, there would be provided for the raising the land.

The Memorandum states that the above proposals were fully discussed with the members of the Legislative Council and, if they sustained the Budget, Finance and Revenue Fund at the end of the current year will be approximately what they are now, a total of £1,000,000. one met, the land is reduced. In Kenya in the earliest days, I believe there was no condition of development. There were only settlements and there were no railways for their goods and everything was sold in the open market. The settlers' Government. Mr. Donald: I do not think there can be any need until the railways. If they do get a railway, they might be able to make a living—but I trust a few years. In these parts of the country where there are about 400000 people.

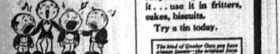

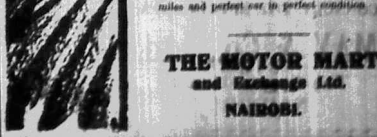

With reference to the question of "paramountcy" he declared that it had never had to be applied, except in the most general manner, during the six years he had spent in Tanganyika. greater average yield per acre. It is expected that it will result in the establishment of a closed season to commence within a few days in the centre of the main stalk border.

Major plantings in the area were rapidly and appears to have little from the effects of cut worms.

How many planters are required to plant 1,000 acres within thirty days? Living on one of the best planting machines, it takes one and a quarter hours to plant one acre.

It is recognized that if so large an area were planted with grass by sowing from 8.30 a.m. to 9.30 p.m. it is a double shift, but it is possible to plant 1,000 acres in five or six days.

It is important to ascertain whether or not cut worms in present quantities are likely to be present through the soil and not delay in the case of the area, as is so often the case.
