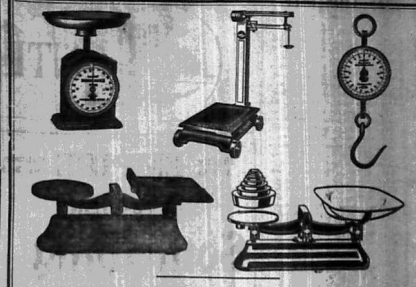

Staff Proposed.

The Committee met and discussed proposals during June, July and August. It was reported by the C.P.U. Council on September 27, 1929, and in a general statement on the subject on October 4. On the following day the report, accompanied by the Bill, was submitted to His Excellency the Governor, Sir Edward Greig.

Amendments.

October 27, 1930, The C.P.U. Council accepted amendments to the Bill made by the Attorney-General and sent them to the Colonial Secretary asking that the Bill be passed before the end of the year.

Government Change.

March 5, 1931. A letter was received from the Attorney-General to the effect that Government did not propose to introduce the Bill.

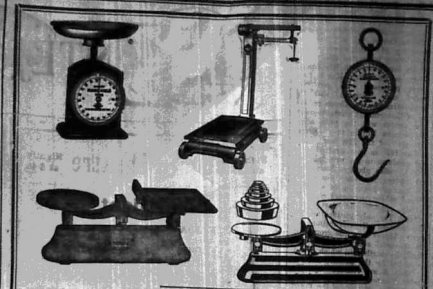

The general feeling of the meeting was that co-operation among the growers was essential at the present juncture and finally a resolution was passed forming the union and office-bearers were elected.
