SENSATIONAL DRAW FOR IRISH SWEEP.

The draw on Saturday was a sensational affair. A man in an attempt, it is believed, to wreck the machinery, when amid momentary consternation, it disappeared into the complicated apparatus.

The ticket was not recovered until after the draw was over when engineers had to dismantle the whole apparatus. Fortunately details had been kept.

One ticket is reported to be held in Kenya in the name of Harriet S. Matthews.

So far very little information is available concerning the distribution of lucky numbers. The draw for the cash prizes will take place to-day.

A further £254,000 will be distributed in prize money to the Calcutta Turf Club. The two first prizes in the Sweep are expected to be at least £105,000 each.

The Calcutta Draw.

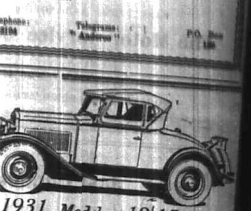


