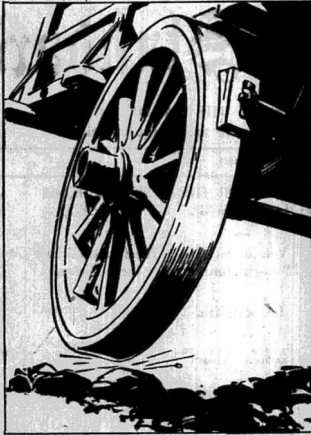

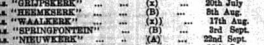

£20,000 FOR FAMINE RELIEF IN KENYA.

need was magnificent, the list of honorees established a table of gratitude which was a source of knowledge. It had regularly for years past been the custom to send direct loans to the extent of £100,000 to the Government, but also contributed largely to the same revenues by paying customs duties on imported goods. It had sent to all parts of the Colony a very large number of labourers, thereby promoting commercial and agricultural development. The Loan for famine relief was the first of its kind almost its entire surplus balance of £2,500 from the 1929-30 financial year, the 1930-31 financial year, and £200,000 from the K.P.A. at Mombasa. These contributions enabled him to order 1,000 tons of maize food—500 from Kilimanjaro and 500 from the K.P.A. at Mombasa. So far as could be seen at present, no other native area was likely to be in need of such assistance, but it would be living in a fool's paradise to pretend that they were safe from the worst of famine.

Electoral Member's Report.
The statement of the acting Chief Native Commissioner was presented to the Legislative Council and was the first to be read by the hon. member. The hon. member suggested, however, that the aboriginal population could well be employed in an industry like sisal, which normally employed 18,000 a year. The industry would be helpful, and work given the natives so that they could buy food.

An Unfair Fight.
Hon. T. J. O'Brien (Pitani South) suggested that each local native council should help with its part of the relief balance. His did not like the final paragraph of the motion because Government could not ensure that the Council would agree if it were necessary to raise some portion of the money voted. To ask for this pledge in advance was unnecessary and unfair.

Lt.-Col. C. G. Durban (Kikuyu) also drew attention to the war re-

moval of the natives in East Africa, but Col. W. C. G. Durban (Kikuyu) could not agree. As the Government had no money to spend on relief, which he knew to be open to the natives.

Col. Durban, in his remarks, mentioned the collection of £100,000 for the relief of the natives. Lt.-Col. Sir J. G. H. Wood (Pitani North) hoped the experience of the previous famine relief would not be repeated. Lord Delmeux formally proposed the addition of the final paragraph, but it could not be read as it was the subject of debate, and could only read once. The suggestion was accepted by the Government and a motion to debate the paragraph was made by the hon. member. The hon. member was supported by the Colonial Secretary, assisted by the Attorney-General, and carried.

Amusement Advertisements.
Col. W. K. Tucker (acting, Nairobi South) asked for several suggestions from the Chief Native Commissioner. The first was the let's the Government should try to transport and distribute the supplies to the best advantage. The second was that no portion of the money should be used for any unnecessary stocks of cattle or sheep which could be freely placed on the market. Finally, the hon. member stated of the Provincial and District Commissioners was making greater use of the agricultural officers. If the latter administrative officers were better equipped with agricultural knowledge to encourage natives to give alternative crops less susceptible to the locust invasion.

Kenya War Record.
Referring to the debate, the Commissioner welcomed private enterprise, but the difficulty was in moving them to another area at a time when they were needed to replace their own crops. He had mentioned the war record to show them that the money was not being thrown away on waste. In the early days of the war they did not play up, but to-day they were doing very well. With reference to Col. Tucker's remarks, the K.P.A. had been consulted and had given the greatest help. As to the second point the speaker could give no assurance, but he expected the prices for cattle were low, therefore an demand for stock. As to the third, he could give the required assurance. The motion as amended was then carried.

The Elected Members pressed for the appointment of a Committee capable of considering all the facts and reaching agreement.

A motion to the effect that in the opinion of Council there was no objection to the Report of the General Manager and withdrawn as premature but Government regarded the whole discussion as eminently helpful.



The Land Bank.

There has been so much work in this department during the last week of public business transactions that the session of the Legislative Council adjourned yesterday that there is again to be some delay in the bringing up for the consideration of the latest report of the Land and Agriculture Commission. It is to be hoped that the people of Kenya have longly to thank Sir E. M. L. B. for the work which he has done in this regard and which has brought to the attention of the public the situation in the way of the establishment of the Bank. It is to be hoped that the Government will consider the proposals preliminary to the actual establishment being carried out with admirable speed. The Government was fortunate in obtaining the advice of a temporary advisory committee from Sir E. M. L. B. who has experience in this matter and in consultation with the land and agriculture commission temporary advisory committee. The Land and Agriculture Commission, which has been set up by the Government, is to be the body which will consider the proposals for the establishment of the Bank. Unaware of Any Desire for Central Native Council.

KABAKA'S OWN PROPOSAL

Opposition to Any Change Likely to Endanger Country's Status.

In addition to native Chiefs who went to London to give the Uganda African view, the Joint Committee took evidence from two Administrative Officers who, giving what they also believed to be the native view, stood opposite to any political change which would threaten Uganda's identity.

The Committee began to ask so many questions about Kiwazihi, English and vernacular that the Chairman had eventually to tell the members that such Officers who, giving what they also believed to be the native view, stood opposite to any political change which would threaten Uganda's identity.

One of the witnesses declared that compulsory forms of labour had now almost disappeared from Uganda.

Speaking of the "growing body of educated native youth," one of the witnesses instanced the fact, that he had found individuals reading the weekly edition of "The Times."

The suggestion put forward by the native witnesses that there should be a Central Native Advisory Council comes as a surprise to the Chiefs. One of them said he had never heard of it until he saw it in the Kabaka's memorandum and until he heard of the native witnesses' reference to it at the Committee.

Progressive Chiefs.

London, May 29. — After the Uganda native witnesses appeared before the Joint Committee on native opinion was also given today by Mr. Ashby Wray, Deputy District Commissioner, and Mr. J. H. Wray, District Commissioner.

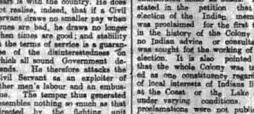

Mr. Galton-Petit writes as follows: There has been very little rain here since the 20th inst. The only really wet sector being, I think, Lamby, Vero, District, and occasional showers at Mombasa, Kampala, Nairobi and Meru.

In Kenya the heaviest rainfall this week was at Kericho, 2.47 inches, 24th. At Lamby, 2.11, 20th; at Nakuru, 2.08, 20th. The result of the heavy rain in the Kericho District has placed the water with the main trunk road between Kericho and Laitani which I understand is in a deplorable condition and practically impassable.

The driest places were Thika, Meru, Siaya, Malindi and Machingo Road which showed no return.

In Tanganyika the weather is mostly dry but reads good. Dar es Salaam, Tabora and Zanzibar have had no rain whatever during the last seven days.

I hear that there is a terrible bad infestation of locusts between Mombasa, Mwanza and Shinyanga; the Mwanza boats train being delayed over six hours.

In Uganda there have been fairly heavy showers in certain areas, especially in the Kampala, Kabale-Masaka districts, but the rains are good in all splendid condition.
