A Letter from Paris.



Roses of a pink shade lend a good tinge to a plain all-cream dress for a winter holiday.

When the figure is small, and the material thin, like poor fangs, heavy silk muscades, or satin beads, this line is delightful. But when the figure is heavy and the material light, the effect is quite disagreeable. In my view there must be a perfect foundation garment beneath a modelled gown.

The evening blouse we see most at the moment, in the plain, one-piece, nicely fitted but by any means overdone, a fairly deep V bust, and a deeper V at the back are characteristics of the bodies which cost the Paris designers are showing. It is light and easy to wear, and the plain black lends itself to original treatment.

The Favorite V Line.

One frock of printed chiffon, in tones of black, yellow, and rose, had this V back, but there was an

absiding edge of the collar from shoulder to waist. The V opening in the middle of the back of the bodice, had been perfectly made, but a square little slit at the waist.

Another beautiful dress—grey blue gown, well modelled about the hips, had no trimming on the bodice, but from the point of the V came down to the knees were two long rays of the same.

An original trimming was made on another model by outlining the shoulder-line back and front with blue flowers made of stiff laid hand-rolled fabric. The front went a little thing in flame satin boucle, and the pendant, very fine green and black. Small roses, hydrangeas, lily carnations, and other flowers, which are fastened to the shoulders, make charming details, which with knicker to match, have taken the place of black quills as large, with black, in silver, gold, or colour.

A SAVORY CHEESE DISH.

Chop the bread nuts and mix them in. Coat each piece of cheese thickly with the batter, and fry golden brown. Drain, sprinkle with grated Parmesan and serve hot with chopped potatoes.
