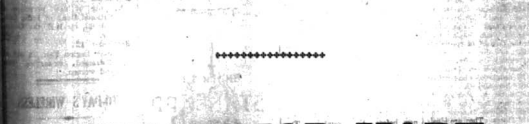

CROP REPORT BASED ON JULY RETURNS.

Effect of Depressed Prices and Locusts.

WHEAT DECLINE.

The Coffee Position Regarded as Satisfactory.

But for the damage done by locusts, crops in most districts of the Highlands would have given good yields.

Estimates based on crop reports for July show that the area under maize is only 1 per cent. below that of last year; but although the acreage under wheat has declined by 17.5 per cent., due to the low market value.

Although this year's coffee crop is expected to be lower than that of last year, the area under coffee is 2,507 acres more than the figure recorded in the Agricultural Census taken on February 29.

The Maize Position.

The following report is based on the first published figures of the 1919-20 crop, and only of the areas planted, but not of the main crops, and general figures of the prospects allowed for these areas. It is not yet premature to attempt the estimation of the total yield.

As expected, the anticipated output of depressed market values the area planted to maize for the present year is 20 per cent. above the previous year.

Estimated conditions during the present year have generally been good. The climate has been favourable for maize, and the crop is generally promising of good yields.

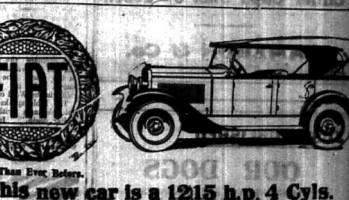

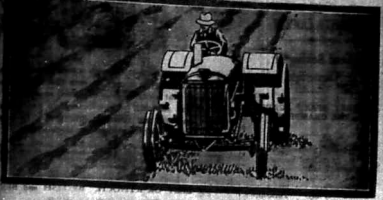
