ATTITUDE DEFINITELY DEFINED.

Labour Opposition Elects its Leaders.

Members of the Conservative and Liberal Parties have discussed their respective attitudes towards the new National Government, and both have decided to cooperate with the Premier and Chancellor in their efforts to balance the Budget.

To elect a Mayor for the ensuing year.

To fix the amount of the salaries and allowances of the Mayor.

To elect a Deputy Mayor for the ensuing year.

To appoint a Committee of the Council and to elect members thereof.

To receive (or otherwise) the report of the proceedings of the following Committees, viz.—Town Planning Special Sub-Committee; General Purposes Committee; Town Planning and Public Health Committee; Municipal Sanitation Committee; Joint Meeting of Mayor Board and Works Committee; Housing Committee; Health and Local Councils Committee.

THE PRINCIPAL DANGER Creation of Separate White and Black Areas in the Colony.

In an address to members of the Nairobi British Club, Lord Francis Scott, leader of the Kenya Delegation to the Joint Parliamentary Committee on Africa gave a review of the work of the Delegation and his impressions of what had been accomplished by it.

He revealed that Lord Passfield in the course of a personal conversation had expressed regret that there had been no mention in the Memorandum on Native Policy of the part played by Europeans of expressing his appreciation of what had been done by settlers in that connection.

Expressing his belief that there was no prospect of political union between the territories in the future, the leader of the Delegation advised the commercial community to concentrate on close economic union. There was no likelihood at all that the Commission would recommend an unofficial majority in the Legislative Council.

Lord Francis stressed his belief that the chief danger lay in the possibility of a recommendation to divide the Colony into white and black areas.

Lord Francis Scott was entertained to Dinner at Nakuru on Saturday night when in the course of a speech he expressed the hope that the Report of the Joint Commission would be largely negative in character.

Lord Passfield's Regret.

While the question of division of the Colony has not been mentioned in the Memorandum on Native Policy, it is believed that the principal aim of the Delegation was to bring to the attention of the Joint Commission on Africa the views of the Colony between the black and white races.
