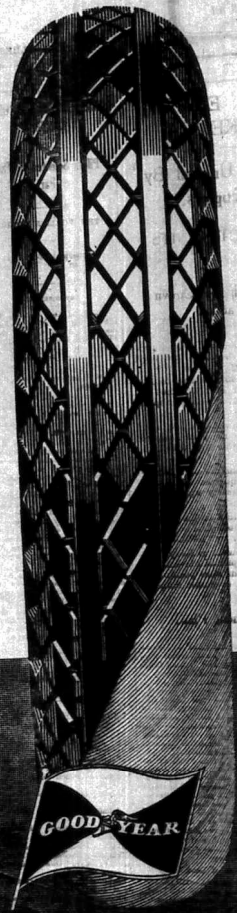

to last a week and for a single man to £2 a week but rarely made industry. The only important detail of the savings plan is the indication that "bonus" will be cut down by ten per cent with the result that the amount of an unemployed single man will be reduced from 17s. 6d. per week to 15s. 6d. per week and in regions where the relief is restricted by the heavy reductions in the national income. The recent revivification by a Commission of Enquiry of the instability of the Unemployment Insurance Fund and the importance of a readjustment to bring it back as far as possible to a self-supporting basis were among the first signs of the urgency of revision of the financial position of the national income. The present position is such that some-thing of the order of the reduction in the allowance for the unemployed will follow. The measures of the committee demanded from the British nation in the second half year of the financial period has fallen on the shoulders of the taxpayer. 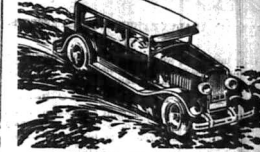
