FURTHER TROUBLE IN THE FAR EAST.

Anti-Japanese Outbreaks in Hong Kong.

MURDERS BY CHINESE BANDITS.

Raiders Derailed the Mukden-Pekin Express.

Following the recent trouble in Manchuria, anti-Japanese demonstrations broke out during the week-end which culminated in the murder of some Japanese residents at Kowloon.

Raiders attacked by armed crowds upon Japanese nationals, resulted in the killing of the Argyl and Sutherland Highlanders, who were eventually compelled to make a bayonet charge upon the mob, in order to prevent a further police station.

The areas of disturbance have been evacuated by Japanese residents who are being given adequate protection at various points. British naval craft are protecting the convoys whereas Japanese ships are alongside.

Chinese bandits derailed the Mukden-Pekin train and killed some 30 people including the driver, fireman and two clerks. Amongst others who were badly injured were an Englishman and a Hindu. The train was also looted.

Belief trains have been despatched to the scene, and Chinese troops are trying to round up the desperadoes.

Efforts to Improve Economic Relations.

Mr. M. Lavelle and Mr. Briand arrived here at 8.47 a.m., today and were welcomed at the station by Dr. Blasing, Dr. Curtis and the Hon. Mr. M. Lavelle. The meeting, with the Hon. Mr. M. Lavelle, was held at 10.30 a.m. and on emerging from the station they were met by a large crowd, who repeatedly waved their flags.

Mr. Lavelle and Mr. Briand arrived at the hotel, Mr. Briand and Mr. Lavelle appeared on the balcony and waved their hands to the crowd, who were shouting "Vive Briand and Lavelle" and "Vive la France".

In a reception to the press at the Grand Hotel, Mr. Lavelle, in a speech which was broadcast throughout Germany, emphasized that the purpose of his visit was to establish friendly relations and develop economic co-operation. He stated that they could not remove all misunderstandings, but they must consider possible solutions in order to prepare for a better future for mutual Franco-German relations, while both countries must be concerned by a tough and yet certain difficult problem which he was going to touch upon.

Mr. Lavelle and Mr. Briand are expected to leave for Nombasa and Mombasa on Saturday. They will probably call at Lindi tomorrow.



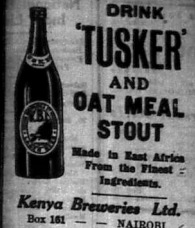

WORLD'S BOILING TITLE.

Berg Loses Third Fight.
CANTONER WINS OF YOUTH.

The following report of the third meeting between Tony Cannoner, the holder, and Bill Berg (London) for the world's lightweight boxing championship of the world is taken from the "East African Standard." At the first meeting of the pair in 1919 at New York, Berg won the verdict on points. The title was won at stake, and the pair met three years in a little town, where Cannoner knocked out the champion Berg in the third round. In their fourth meeting, the holder retained his title in a great exciting winning on points.

In the return match at the Yale Grounds, New York, last night Bill Berg was defeated by Tony Cannoner on points and thus regained his title. Cannoner, who was 21 years of age, won the fight by a margin of 10-8.

An argument over the type of glove that should be used finally caused a postponement of the fight. Research a jet black clear eye and in a stilling atmosphere, three rounds of Englishmen, Italian and Jew mingled together at the Yale Grounds last night.

Started with the punch and fire, with his dipping with preparation, booming starts and rolling up elbows, were a galaxy of mistakes on Cannoner's part.

The Fight.
Round 1—Cannoner shot out at right, but missed. Berg got home a right to the head. Cannoner missed again with a right to the head, but landed with left to the stomach. Berg attacked viciously and landed Tony on the ropes, swinging over his head. He cut the head on Cannoner's shoulder and landed, left and right. Berg's left eye injured in his bout with Jimmy Mansmann and reopened during boxing, began to bleed. Both attacked hard right and left one of these Berg. On getting up the Britisher made right down for a count of eight. Cannoner, who was on his knees, was down again for a short count.

Round 2—Both became more cautious. Berg rubbed in changing blows in a attack. Berg landed with a right to the head and a left to the stomach. Cannoner, playing low, Berg's right eye, landed another hand, right the ropes, swung toward Cannoner, but the ropes, remained his with left in foot and body. Round finished even.
