Church to Resist Interference with Her Property.

The Spanish Premier, Senor Zamora, and the Minister for the Interior, Senor Mantu, have resigned following upon the decision of the Cortes to separate the Church and State, to expel the Jesuits and to confiscate their property. It is stated that the possibility of civil war in Spain is definitely nearer as a result of recent events. It is understood that the Jesuits will resist by any means available with their property.
