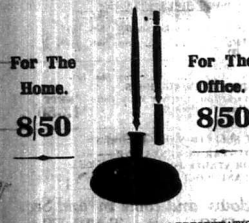

Excise Rules.

PROVISION FOR EAST AFRICAN AIRCRAFT.

There is published for information in last week's Kenya Official Gazette a Bill entitled "The Revenue (Excise) Amendment Ordinance, 1963."

"Excise and custom" are given the following—

"This Bill enables the Governor in Council to enter into agreements with the Government of Kenya and other territories which are or may be ...

(4) that upon the date of the agreement shall impose excise duties at the same rates as ...

(5) that the duties shall be assessed in the same manner as ...

The Interpretation clause states that "excise of excise" means "the internal duties imposed on goods manufactured within the territory, but shall not extend to losses and ..."

"The Governor in Council may enter into an agreement with the Government of any East African Territory providing—

(1) that no duty of excise not already existing shall be imposed by one party to the agreement without prior consultation with the other party to the agreement as to its imposition and the rate of duty to be imposed;

(2) that the parties to the agreement shall forthwith in accordance with the terms of the agreement articles or commodities manufactured in the territory of both parties to the agreement;

(3) that the parties to the agreement shall indemnify the other party in respect of any articles or commodities which have been manufactured in the territory of one party and removed into the territory of the other party to the agreement;

(4) that where such articles or commodities are subsequently imported into the territory of any other East African Territory such other party shall assume the full amount of any excise or duty payable in respect of such articles or commodities to be paid over to the Government of such Territory;

Every agreement entered into shall be published in the Gazette.

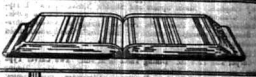

INCREASED REPRESENTATION.

The Report of the East African Joint Committee was issued in Nairobi yesterday. The following points are taken from the numerous recommendations:—

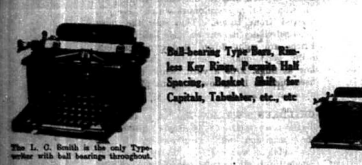

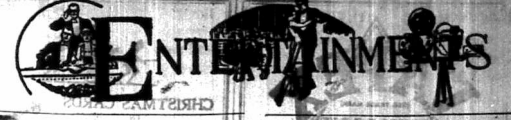

First Meeting of Control Board.

APPLICATIONS FOR LICENCES.

Objections by Representative of Railway Administration.

The first meeting of the Road Transport Control Board, appointed under the Carriage of Goods by Motor Ordinance met in Nairobi on Monday to consider applications for licences by owners of motor lorries to carry goods over certain specified roads in Kenya.

The Railway Administration was represented and a general objection was lodged against granting any of the licences, chiefly on the grounds that the lorries would carry certain classes of goods at a lower rate than that charged by the railway which had to carry all classes, some at a very low rate.

It was also pointed out that the railway carried a tremendous tonnage for which this class of freight would not be carried by the lorries, which only transported goods on which higher rates were charged. In this way it was alleged, the lorries were "picking the eyes" of the transport business.

The Railway Administration, however, were prepared to withdraw all objections, if the vehicles licensed were prepared to charge rates equal to those of the railway.

A letter was also submitted by the Director of Public Works opposing all applications on the ground that the lorry service would cause irreparable damage to the roads, and that the conveyance of goods by the railway was adequate.

The Board's proceedings were as follows: Mr. G. D. MacGregor, Chairman, opened the meeting by stating that the Board had received applications for licences to transport goods on certain roads in Kenya. He stated that the Board had to consider these applications in the light of the Carriage of Goods by Motor Ordinance and the Road Transport Act, 1949.

Mr. H. Ripley, a director, expressed his opinion that the Board should not grant any of the licences, as this would be a serious blow to the transport business in Kenya. 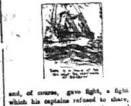
