Draastic steps to improve the financial situation are being taken by the Government in New Zealand and Australia.

Proposals include immediate reductions in the salaries of Civil Servants and increased taxation.

A Grave Statement.

(THROUGH REUTER'S AGENCY.)

Wellington, February 19.—A grave statement regarding the grave financial difficulties which the Dominion has made by the Prime Minister.

Mr. Forbes declared that the public service would have to make economies and wage cuts in all services, including those of Cabinet Ministers and Members of Parliament, and that the public service would have to wait four months from April 1, while the wages of people engaged in public works will be reduced by 10 per cent.

It is anticipated that, apart from the reduction in the figures, the new wage will probably amount to \$120,000, and the value of exports will be reduced by \$100,000, so that the total reduction will be \$200,000, or more, in the first year.

INFRINGEMENT OF COPYRIGHT & PIRACY.

"E. A. Standard" vs.
"Times of East Africa."

INJUNCTION AGREED TO.

The question of the protection of a newspaper's rights in copyright of news has been raised in the "Times of East Africa" in the subject of judgments in India and elsewhere.

It is believed to be unfortunate that the "Times of East Africa" has decided some time ago to sue the "E. A. Standard" for infringement of copyright. 
