PAULING'S AGREEMENT.

London, Friday.

Brown French, representative of the world renowned railway contractors in London, has signed a contract with the Chinese Government to lay a railway from China to a point opposite the port of Taku in the Peiping-Tientsin Valley.

Under the contract, which will be completed in 1916, the Chinese Government will pay £1,000,000 per mile for the construction of the line from Chingtu to Charhsia, the capital of the province. The agreement requires the payment of £1,000,000 by the Chinese Minister of Finance.

COFFEE PROSPECTS.

After the coffee ranches are a perfect picture, and prospects are good in the districts preparing land as far as possible for coffee, a large increased acreage of the Mombasa region. Thousands of trees may now be seen all over the country, and the coffee bushes, loaded with blossoms, less than a month after planting have in the nursery, while one can hardly believe that they were imported for young trees about 18 months ago already have four times their size.

CITERUS FRUIT.

(b) The disadvantage of this method of cultivation is that the maize is not harvested, and the maize field is left to grow wild, while it is a waste of land.
