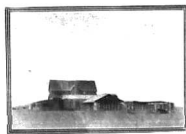

**INCREASE IN NUMBER OF BANKRUPTCIES.**

**Registrar General's Report for 1930.**

Disclosed in "The Registrar General's Report for the year 1930" published by the Registrar-General, it is also stated that several other factors have influenced the increase in the number of bankruptcies. These factors include the general economic depression, the falling prices of commodities, and the increasing cost of living. The report also notes that the number of bankruptcies in 1930 was 1,200, compared with 1,100 in 1929.

The number of companies on the register on January 1, 1930, was 200. During the year, 100 public companies and 10 private companies of which the number was made that one was "limited by purchase" and 48 private companies with a nominal capital of £1,485,500, were registered. Public and private companies were wound up 30 and 20 respectively. 24 public and 15 private companies were, at the time the report was compiled, in course of liquidation. These public companies were converted into private ones, and at the end of the year the total number of private companies was 414. Ten foreign companies were registered and one struck off. 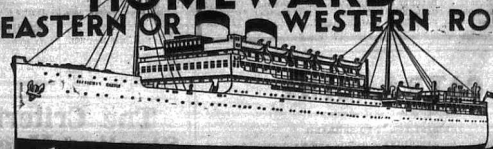
