BROADCASTING CONTROVERSY.

Complaint by C.P.U.
on Market Talk.

Comments of a broadcast made on the subject of "Market and Crop" by Mr. T. E. Tynan, have been made to the British Council by the East African Society, by the Secretary of the Government of Kenya, and by the East African Broadcasting Commission. It is the opinion of one of the greatest interest to the C.P.U. that Mr. Tynan was fully justified in making the statement that his comments on the complaints have been advanced.

The C.P.U. has complained that a meeting has passed between the Secretary of the Government and the East African Broadcasting Company and Mr. Tynan's remarks on the subject of "Market and Crop" have been withdrawn.

Due to the fact that complaints have been received by me from persons who have received the tone and manner of Mr. O. Tynan's broadcast on market and crop, I have decided to withdraw at a meeting of a Committee of the C.P.U. on Friday, August 11th, 1955.
