COST OF LIVING IN NAIROBI

Slight Fall During Month of August.

The general level of retail prices of food materials in Nairobi during August does not show very much difference as compared with the previous month, according to figures compiled by the Government Statisticians. The difference is 0.8 per cent, only below July, but higher than the month of January, 1910. It is noted, however, that while there were certain factors there are mentioned as reflecting adjustments in certain classes.

The Statisticians state that the principal change in the price of groundnuts is an increase of nearly 2 per cent in the average price of local flour, 1.1 per cent higher, 4.8 per cent higher in the price of Indian rice, 1.1 per cent higher, 1.7 per cent higher in the price of South African (Pretoria), 2 cents higher in New Zealand, 14 cents in Canada and England and 19 cents in Australia (Sydney and Melbourne).

Again, the average price of 20 cents per lb. of sugar in Nairobi may be compared with the 20 cents in South African (Cape), in England and 19 cents in New Zealand. The average price of milk is 20 cents in Nairobi, 20 cents in Pretoria, 20 cents in Australia, 24 cents in England and Canada and 28 cents in New Zealand.

Creamery butter can be purchased in Nairobi at 9s. 1/8 per lb. while the price of farm butter from the coast is 11s. 1/2. In London daily retail (cashed) costs 1. 1/2 per lb.
