Mr Balwary said that Uganda's economy was based on agriculture, and that there was no advantage, or even a slight disadvantage, over the high rate charged for shipping in by the import duty on cotton, which was the chief export of Uganda.

He pointed out that at present the import duty on cotton was 40%, and that the cost of the cotton amounted to £71,770.

Mr Balwary said that the railway revenue by Uganda's railways was not sufficient to meet the concession made to other industries in Kenya. He said that the railways were not able to compete with the high road charges in Kenya, and that the railways could not compete with the road ports after the sale of cotton was very great indeed.

Mr Balwary said that the Colonial Office recommended that the Board of Officers should make a statement on the question of the danger of encouraging cotton growing, and said that if the cotton growing could be paid to the railways, the railways would be better off.

## EAST AFRICAN OFFICE IN LONDON.

**Dual Posts of Commissioner to be Dissolved.**

### GOVERNMENT DECISION.

#### Contributions Towards Upkeep Reduced.

It is officially announced that the Department of Overseas Trade is terminating the arrangement under which the duty of the Trade Commissioner for East Africa and Commissioner for the East African Dependencies Trade and Information Office in London has been combined.

This arrangement has existed to end and an arrangement which has existed since 1919, when Col. Mackenzie took up a temporary appointment to hold the post. This position has been reviewed from time to time.

The income of the E.A. London Office has suffered reductions this year owing to certain of the territories responsible for its maintenance reducing their contributions.

The subject has also been considered in Kenya, where there is a demand for a different system of publicity, and a sub-committee of the Select Committee on the 1922 Budget has recommended that the Kenya Government may be forced to review the position.

#### A Question of Economy.

Representation has been received from the Secretary of State for India and the Colonies, asking him to consider the advisability of creating a "Dual" structure which would combine the duties of H.M. Trade Commissioner for India and Commissioner for the East African Dependencies, and to advise him whether such a change would be in the best interests of the two Commissions.

At present, the two Commissions are separated by the end of May, 1922.

The sub-committee, however, has taken advantage of the opportunity of placing an interim report before the Government, derived from a joint opinion obtained by the Commissions, C. B. D. S.O., and the Director of the Overseas Trade during the time that the two reports have been prepared.
