**FRENCH STRANGLEHOLD ON GERMAN FINANCES.**

**Refusal to Renew Short Term Credits.**  
**A NEW CRISIS.**

**International Bank Also Swayed by Decision.**

January 11.—Paris, January 11.—The refusal to renew for more than a month short term credits expiring next month, to the Reich Bank, is a serious threat to the German economy.  
The full significance of this decision is demonstrated by the action of the Bank of International Settlements which has declined to renew credits to Germany until the Bank of England, the Bank of France and the Federal Reserve Bank guarantee their credits, for like amounts.

It is thought that the latest development may precipitate a new crisis in German finances.

**Reply to Dr. Bruening.**

At the instance of M. Merz, Governor of the Bank of France, the Council of the Bank of International Settlements today unanimously refused to re-open its credit to Germany unless the Government by whom the credit is guaranteed repays it.  
The credit of the Bank of France was not disrupted to meet the needs of the Reich which draws on it.

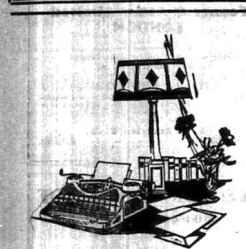

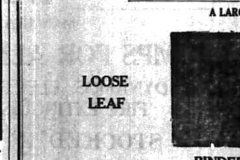

HOW TO KILL UNWANTED TREES.

King-Barking and Poisoning Methods.

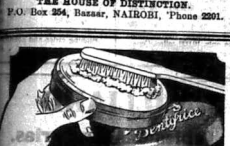
