No Further Peace Moves.

TROOPS NOT YET WITHDRAWN BUT ARE AWAITING EVENTS.

Conflicting reports have been received from China as to the situation in the war zone. Further military moves have been reported, but have not been decided.

Japanese cavalry patrols have been in action with Chinese troops, but the Japanese headquarters have explained that these patrols are merely small bodies operating beyond the Japanese lines to guard against surprise attacks.

No withdrawals of troops have taken place, and no neutral zone has been organized. Both the Japanese and Chinese troops remain in position facing each other and awaiting events.

The British Press has expressed its satisfaction at the work of the League of Nations in focusing public opinion on the vital necessity of the observance of the Covenant and the Kellogg Pact.

The Maize Industry in Kenya.

A RECENT LECTURE BY AGRICULTURAL OFFICER.

Value of Seed Competition.

RESULTS OF EXPERIMENTAL WORK DURING LAST YEAR.

The following are reports of lectures given by Colin Baker, B.A. (Hons) Dip. Agr. (Camb) A.I.C.T. (Transit), Agricultural Officer, Kikuyu at the recent Farmers' Days at Nakuru and Kikuyu.

Mr. Baker commenced by expressing the regret of Mr. Burdon, the Kenyan Plant Breeder, that had done so much towards the inclusion of the Maize Seed Competition, that it was unable, owing to the illness, to attend those exhibits of the first Seed Competition held to give the lecture.

Mr. Baker's address was divided into four parts, the first two of which he was devoting to Mr. Burdon. The four sections were as follows:

I. The Maize Seed Competition.
II. Remarks on Maize Growing and Some Benefits of Experimental Work on Maize During 1933.
III. Maize Diseases.
IV. Green Manuring.

Maize Seed Competition.
The Maize Seed Competition of 1933 was held in conjunction with the Royal Agricultural and Horticultural Society of Kenya. The competitors in the Trans-Nairobi and Nyeri sections were judged on the results of statistical field trials conducted at Kikuyu and Nyeri by the Department of Agriculture and typical groups of rows of maize from the entries (total selected ones, as Mr. Baker pointed out) were exhibited on the Farmers' Days.

The object of these competitions is to encourage growers in the production of quantities superior to their own requirements, of high yielding, disease-resistant and maize Seed Growers' Association, members of which will sell good reliable seed at a profit according to the regulations of the Association.

It was remarked that it was gratifying to the Department of Agriculture to know that the growers, it was thought without exception, had selected those seed and registered to type and bred from exemplified by the data from the

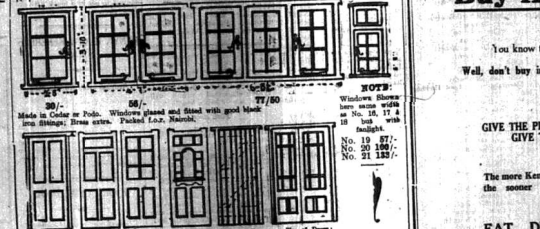

4. Fertilizing food for nitriding organisms which form nitrous oxide. These organisms will only be active if the soil is kept below 60° F. however.

5. Holding lime and phosphorus in the soil and preventing their leaching out of reach of the roots of the plants.

Kinds of Green Manures.

Green manures may be divided into two groups: leguminous and non-leguminous. The former is made up of plants which are rich in nitrogen and which are able to fix nitrogen from the atmosphere in the soil. Legumes will grow in any soil and under any conditions. The former class is the most valuable one and most green manures commonly used fall within it. Legumes will give an extra crop of 25 to 50 per cent over the ordinary crop.
