TURNING ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS INTO SECRET APPEAL COURTS.

The Law Society of Uganda have laid before the Legislative Council a petition objecting to the terms of a new Bill introduced by Government which would remove the normal courts from the present judicial system and substitute administrative tribunals, which would share the right of appeal to the High Court and the Court of Appeal and substitute instead a system of appeal through the Secretary of State or the Governor.

The Society maintain that under the constitution of Uganda this interference with the powers of the Judiciary is ultra vires and the Governor is requested to withhold his approval of the Bill until His Majesty's Government has given its assent.

The Bill described as "an attempt, not only to check the increased importance of the Judiciary but very definitely and drastically to limit the powers and jurisdiction they now have, and to give the Executive and the Executive much greater powers than they had prior to the establishment of the courts in Uganda."

The Bill has not been explained to the native (apartly the Buganda Province) will be exempt (except the Kabaka objects) and the Law Society maintain that the Government has no right to deprive the Africans of their birthright of British justice.

Employment of Counsel Barred.
