PLAN TO BENEFIT PROTECTORATE BY EXTENSION TO THE CONGO.

In the course of an official reply to representations from Uganda protesting against the decision not to include Kampala on the route between Cairo and the Cape, a representative of Imperial Airways sets out the reasons which have influenced the decision.

It is contended that Uganda is unable to offer the facilities that would give it the full saving of two days which is the company's objective, while the suggestion that a course across Lake Victoria and Western Tanganyika is dismissed as impracticable on the grounds of expense and the unsuitability of several of the aerodromes on the proposed route.

It is argued further that the provision of a feeder service to Uganda will meet all the reasonable requirements of that territory.

Finally it is pointed out that the Air Ministry which is the guardian of the interests of all the territories, has approved the route as present being used.

DE VALERA'S DECLARATION IN REGARD TO OATH.

Bill Again Before the Dail.

DESCRIBED BY OPPOSITION LEADER AS POLITICAL CHICANEY.

The De Valera Government was defeated in the Dail on Wednesday, the Labour members voting with the Opposition against the Government's proposal to ratify the whole of the Oath of Allegiance Bill, on the ground that the Government had not accepted the terms of the Oath.

In moving the second reading of the Oath Bill, Mr. De Valera declared that at the moment the people are quite ready to lead them. He added that the Government was determined to go to the bitter end of the road.

He stressed that the removal of the Oath was a violation of the Treaty with Britain. He further stated that he did not intend to be drawn into any negotiation on the subject.

Mr. W. T. Cosgrave described the bill as "one of the greatest pieces of political dishonesty in history."




