Mr. de Valera's chief demand was a united Ireland as a republic, with "one form of association with the Empire," and "in some circumstances and some seasons the King to be recognised as the head of the association."

He also demanded the abolition of the oath and of the payment of the land annuity, while he also declined to have the matter referred to an impartial tribunal on the grounds that the "dice would be loaded against Ireland."

During the subsequent debate, Mr. Lloyd George, in his first speech in the new Parliament, strongly supported the Government.


