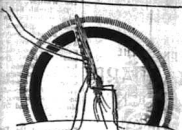

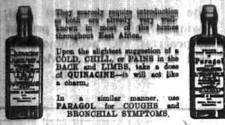

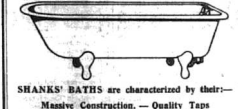

# Judicial Enquiry into Wassin Land Case.

## ARAB CLAIMS ON THE SHIMONI PENINSULA.

### The Story of Early Settlement

#### RECOMMENDATIONS INCLUDE SURVEY OF FARMS AND HOMESTEADS.

At the request of the Elected Members of the Kenya Legislative Council a Committee, headed by Mr. Justice Dickson, was appointed on August 19, 1951 to enquire into the circumstances in which, in October 1929, certain Arabs of Wassin Island surrendered their individual claims for various areas of land on the Shimoni Peninsula in the Dipu District of the Coast Province.

Evidence was taken by Mr. Justice Dickson at Mombasa in the following November when some twenty-four witnesses were examined. The Report of the Committee, which has now been published, contains an allegation made against the then Provincial Commissioner at the Coast, Mr. Montgomery, of having used pressure and threats to make them withdraw certain claims was not believed by Mr. Justice Dickson.

Amongst the recommendations which the Government has decided to accept, it is suggested that the Arab claimants should be asked to bring their individual claims before the Registrar of Titles as if they had never remained in abeyance. It is also proposed that surveys of individual homesteads and farms should be dealt with at once.

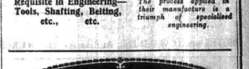

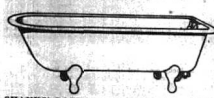
