Properties Offered But No Bid.

Not one of eight farms which were offered for sale by Messrs. J. & S. de la Rue, 100, Upper Circular Road, at the New Broadway Hotel, yesterday afternoon.

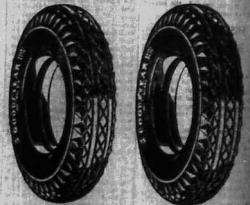

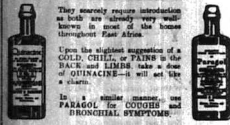
