



### Attack on Europeans.

"No guilty," was the plea of the native who was charged with having attempted to attack an European. Mr. Pearson gave corroborative evidence which was further corroborated by Mr. Murray, who, employed at Mr. Pearson's stall, was sitting at the time of the attack.

Accused denied the instant he had been hit in the eye by the knife, but that he had dropped the knife when they were struggling.

As the accused wished to call a witness for the defence, he was remanded until Saturday morning.

It was stated that at the shop where the native was working he had been employed by Mr. Harry Lee, a native, for 20 months.

On the 2nd instant, at about 10 a.m., he had been hit in the eye by the knife.

A. J. P. Green, Inspector of Finger Print Expert, reported that he had been present at the trial.

Inspector Maguire told the Court that he had been hit in the eye and had found a right thumb impression and a right ring finger impression on the native's left hand, which he had photographed, and on comparison with the prints taken from the native he had been able to identify the native as the person for whom he was sentenced to six months' hard labour.

Accused was then sentenced to six months' hard labour and was ordered to remain in custody for three years after his release.

### No Licence.

The Manager of the Express Transport Co. was charged with having driven a motor vehicle on a public road without being licensed to do so.


