I do not propose that any change should be made in the present arrangement which secures an official majority in the Legislative Council. This sentence occurs in the recent despatch addressed by the Secretary of State to the Colonial Secretary of Kenya.

Whilst the Minister agrees that the time is not ripe for Africans to sit on the Kenya Legislative Council he is in agreement with the Governor that the representation of native interests should not be restricted to Christian Missionaries. The representation of native interests will be increased by the addition of a nominated member.

DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE LOCUST INFESTATION.

The first crop report for the 1920-1921 season, which has just issued by the Statistical Branch of the Department of Agriculture, reveals the estimate of average yields for principal crops gives a general review of the prospects attending their harvest.

Although it is not yet premature to attempt the estimation of the yields which may be expected there are indications that there will be a substantial increase in the volume of agricultural exports in 1921 compared with 1920.

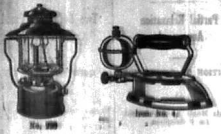
