The settlement of the major issue in the Lancashire cotton dispute has been effected after negotiations lasting for eight days between the representatives of the employers and the operatives.

It has been agreed that the workers' wages will be reduced by Shs. 1/8 in the period, as compared with the employers' original demand of Shs. 2/8, and the operatives' offer of Shs. 1/4.

A general resumption of work is not expected immediately as the employers' organization has still to meet for the purpose of ratifying the agreement.

There is still one important problem outstanding, namely, the reinstatement of the workers who were already on strike before the general stoppage began. A representative sub-committee is still engaged on this subject, and proposals have been submitted to the operatives' representatives.

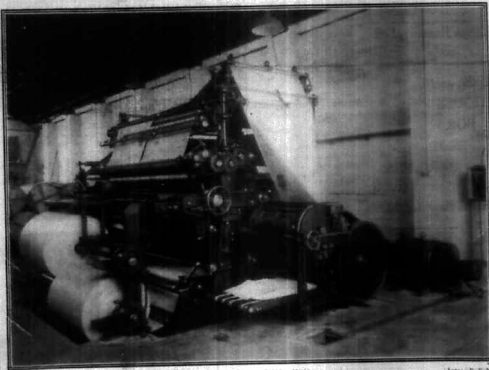



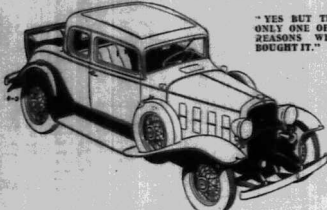

1902 - HISTORY OF THE "EAST AFRICAN STANDARD" - 1932

Today's issue of the East African Standard has been printed on the first newspaper history printing machine ever used in Eastern Africa. The introduction of a machine marks a big step forward in newspaper work in this territory. Priority of interest to the East African Standard for development must necessarily attract attention throughout the territory where the newspaper has been published and with whose history and progress the journal has been identified.

It is not too much to claim that the East African Standard is one of the most important news of the life of East Africa. For a very long time it has been the only news paper published in the territory and with very increased demand to the advancement of East Africa.

The East African Standard has shared in the prosperity and setbacks which the territories have experienced and it has won through as an established institution.

The revenue associated with the growth of any business is always largely not only to cover directly connected with the business, but also to the public generally. The truth of that is even more apparent when the development of a new country. When, however, the undertaking is that of rendering day by day the details of the country's business and life, the historical aspects of development there is provided a new which is part of the very life of the country. The files of the East African Standard provide not only a record of the history of East

A Record of Progress During 30 Years.

and Mayer and in the same year they started a weekly newspaper with the same title as familiar throughout these territories and far beyond their boundaries. Considerable difficulties attended in running any kind of a newspaper in those primitive days in Mombasa. There was no electric power and no machinery had to be used. All the type was hand-set and the actual printing machine had to be operated by manual labor. It proved it is interesting to know that one of these early machines is still in existence at Mombasa where it is used as a study plant. What is even more remarkable is that

The Modern Works.

Today the East African Standard has the most up-to-date and modern printing and newspaper plant in the whole of Eastern Africa. Its composing room is equipped with a battery of eight linotype galleys including the most modern electric machine, while the mechanical printing department is equal to producing the most delicate four color work furnished by modern requirements. The book binding department has amongst other equipment modern fitting and book sewing machines. The press department is a model of its kind and the plant used is represented as the most up to date procurable. Every one of the picture galleys became a feature of the paper, the East African Standard has installed all its resources without stint in the perfecting of this process of photographic reproduction.

The East African Standard contains many examples of advertisements which hardly fail to every part. There is no advertisement in which they do not play a leading part; there is no way they cannot supply

For the advertiser they represent the most powerful, the most efficient, and the most up-to-date machinery which he needs to get his goods.

The 1903 first issue comprised 13 pages. Today its staff numbers 250. Its circulation and influence have grown throughout the continent of the East African Standard, whose news is first in the continent of Africa, and it has been deemed to install new machinery costing many thousands of pounds.

A Wonderful Machine.

The big printing machine which was manufactured with the most up-to-date and which has revolutionized today's news is the most up-to-date of its kind. It is known as the Comoro Motor and is a ponderous piece of mechanism. It weighs 39 tons and put in almost three in operation.
