Two years ago today! Indeed it is a sad coincidence, a group of us here, the bearers of the wreath, to lay it on the grave of the late King Edward VII, for the Crown and Hamilton defended.

The Captain of the General ordered the crew, showing that the alleged offence of "gross negligence" of the officers, who had been given charge of the ship's stores, was the cause of the accident, that the ship was a dawdler in port, and that she was to be held responsible for the loss of life.

SHORTAGE OF LABOUR.

Good news to the planters, and to all business men, is that the coffee plantations are busy planting out cuttings, the only work now being done is cutting out old trees. It is often wondered why the Government does not import labour from Mysore to do this work, but the answer is that the Government would then be forced to pay the settlers, and the cost of bringing over labour from Mysore, and getting them to settle over the rivers on the Nyeri River flat, and judging by the pace at which the settlers are moving, there is no chance that they carry about 100 lbs. there should not be much trouble in spending £30,000,000 here.

There is a boom in Cottages, planting in progress, and the number of people moving up to the present there are no more than 1000.

Planters seem to think that by raising the native wages slightly above those paid by their neighbours they can obtain labour more easily, and that the natives will be willing to work to obtain their ends as the master and his wife, and other tax.

With wages of £1 a week, an East African who works 10 hours a day, will earn £4700 in 17 weeks, and applied to the one month's rent of a holding.


