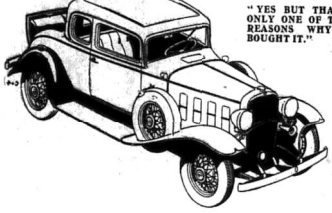

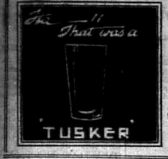

POSSIBLE ENQUIRY INTO CRIMINAL PROCEDURE REGARDING NATIVES.

A Conference of Law Officers of the Crown of Kenya, Uganda and Tanganyika will be held early next year to review the existing Civil and Criminal Codes of the three territories. Also early in the year Mr. H. G. Byles, Legal Adviser to the Dominions and Colonies Office, will visit Nairobi with the purpose of establishing contact with the local officers of the three territories and to discuss legal questions.

It has been suggested that Mr. Byles may also advise himself in the question of the administration of justice among the natives. The appointment of such a Commission of Enquiry was recommended following the presentation of the report of the enquiry into the Wajuhit murder case.

A Forehanded Commission.

In the early part of next year a committee of Forehanded Commission to the Crown of Kenya, Uganda and Tanganyika is to be held in Kenya to review the Criminal and Procedural Codes of the three territories.

Another member of the unemployed movement was charged with distributing seditious literature and with harrying police to assist the police. He was bound over to keep the peace for six months.

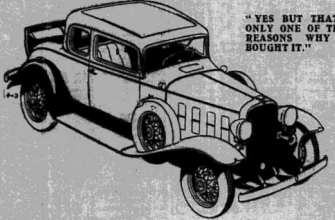

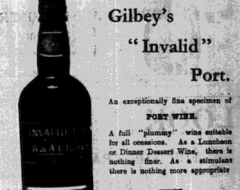
