



Further declines in the estimates of the main crops in Kenya are reported for the month of November as compared with the estimates for the previous menth.

ise is now expected to yield 1,010,720 bags—a reduction of 17,405 as compared with the October figures. This decrease has been caused to a great extent by locusts.

The estimated yield of wheat has been reduced to a figure of 144,755 bags as compared with 173,180 bags in October. A large proportion of this decline has been caused by black stem rust and locust damage, chiefly in the Uasin Gishu area.
