LIBERAL MINISTERS OPPOSE INTRODUCTION.

A New Principle.

MR. BALDWIN EXPLAINS THE REASON FOR "AGREEING TO DIFFER."

London, February 4. Chamberlain's speech regarding the Ottawa tariff for general goods has set off a general storm of protest. Chamberlain, Chancellor of the Exchequer, announced that he had decided to introduce a system of moderate protection, substantially adjusted to the needs of industry and agriculture in order to remedy the adverse balance.

From March 1 a basic duty of 10 per cent would be imposed upon all imports, except wheat, meat, fish, raw cotton, wool, and other goods already subject to a tariff. A supplementary duty of 10 per cent would be raised on 10 per cent of such goods. The new duties would be imposed on January 1, 1933, and would be subject to a supplementary duty of 10 per cent.

Empire Preference. Mr. Baldwin's speech and the additional duties would be operative on goods from India or the Dominions before the Ottawa conference. The new duties would be applied to the Colonies, Protectorates and Mandated Territories with a supplementary duty of 10 per cent.

Government attacked the utmost importance of the Ottawa Conference and intended to secure a great success in its negotiations.

The additional duty would amount to 100 per cent on certain raw materials and certain British goods.

To be Used by the League of Nations.

FRENCH PROPOSAL TO THE GENÈVA CONFERENCE.

Dramatic Surprise.

AN EFFORT TO MAKE THE COVENANT REALLY EFFECTIVE.

The creation of an International Force to prevent war, placed at the disposal of the League of Nations is proposed by the French Delegation to the Disarmament Conference.

If the plan is accepted the Force would include a fleet of four bombing planes which would act as a sort of strike police force.

Other proposals put forward are the abolition of warships of over ten thousand tons, submarines, tanks and bombing aircraft.

The French proposal, however, is not likely to meet with general acceptance.

It is pointed out that the League was formed as a system of free nations, each retaining its own independent sovereignty and that international disputes were to be settled by peaceful methods of arbitration and mediation.

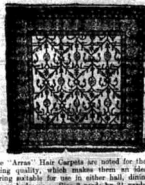

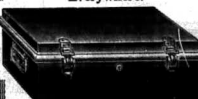

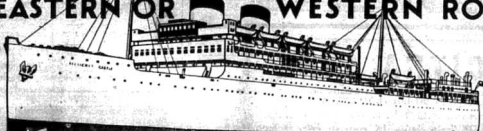
