# CRISIS IN SISAL INDUSTRY

## Effect of British Import Duties Bill

### POSSIBILITY OF FOREIGN HEMP BEING ON FREE LIST.

#### Protest by Empire Fibre Interests.

#### AGREEMENTS DECISION NOT YET ANNOUNCED.

London, February 15.—The Import Duties Bill which will reduce the duties on foreign hemp to 50 per cent, has caused considerable concern among the sisal and manilla producers of the Empire.

The fact and hemp are further dried after scorching or deoiling.

The East African sisal interests here are bitterly opposed to this proposal, since they claim that there is a definite prospect of a free market for their product in the Colonies, that foreign seed would be sufficient to do up to 40 per cent, while seed grown in the Empire would be excluded.

The rope manufacturers of the Empire would also be affected. It is estimated that the Sisal and Manilla Manufacturers' Association in this country has a 50 per cent. protection against foreign sisal, and that the rope makers here are mostly made from East African sisal, which is a much higher quality than sisal imported.

Foreign hemp is being used in the Empire to a large extent, and the fact that the duties on it are to be reduced to 50 per cent, is a serious matter to the sisal producers.
