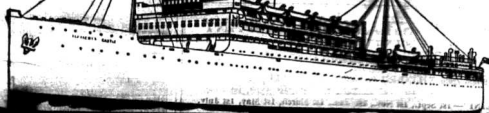

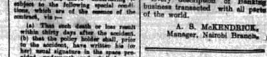

This it is added is inevitable owing to the influx of natives to the towns and the rise in adult crime.
