Its peoples will be dealt with under three heads (1) the Hamitic Tribes (2) the Coastal Bantu Tribes, (3) the Gusha or mixed Bantu Tribes, consisting chiefly of "enslaved or liberated Somali slaves. The manners and customs of these tribesmen will be touched upon as will their political and economic importance. The future of Jubaland will be dealt with (1) the development by white occupation (2) the political possibilities. The author was formerly a District Commissioner in Jubaland where he has spent nearly three years. He has been associated with the Administrative Service of the Protectorate some thirteen years, and is therefore fully qualified to give an authoritative opinion on these subjects.
