ALSACE RE-TAKEN.

Mulhausen Occupied.

GERMAN TROOPS ROUTED. Brilliant Success of French Cavalry.

[TERRACQUE AGENTS' AGENCY.]

London, Monday.

The Bank of England discount is reduced to 5 per cent.

A wireless message has been received from the Louisiana that all is well. Another's correspondent writes that the French cavalry made a rapid advance on the east of Long.

The British forces on the field coast in the instruction of Mr. Hagenau seized Limon in German Topographical West Africa without resistance, and South Uganda to 120 kilometers north from the Coast. This has been successfully completed.

Another's correspondent in St. Petersburg writes that a German fleet of twelve battleships and cruisers are including with French fleets at Koenigsberg and Varna. The decrease in imports is £2,309,401 in exports £275,882.

Women non-combatants of Paris and other parts of France are going in the boats to assist the harvesting.

The French and German forces met at Altkich in equal strength. The French met the successive lines of combats with the result that the Germans fell pell-mell. The French dragoons pushed through Mulhausen close on the heels of the remainder of the fleeing troops, the inhabitants of Mulhausen repeatedly received the French troops.

The British Government send congratulations to General Joffre on his success. In Montenegro the Agrarian Ambassador received his passport.

The gold influx in England amounts to £17,000.

Another's correspondent cables from Melbourne that Cook made a statement to the people of Australia in which he says he must see this through, whatever the difficulty and at whatever cost we must preserve the great fabric of British freedom, remember that we are Britons."

A Paris message says the French troops crossed the frontier at Alton and seized Altkich, after a fierce battle. They pursued the retreating Germans, and continued the movement in the direction of

Mulhausen. The success of the French troops was extremely brilliant.

Another message says the French troops have entered Mulhausen.

The people of Alsace-Lorraine were overjoyed at the news of the French troops and they set up the boundary marks.

Mr. Churchill has accepted the Duchess of Cornwall's offer of a hospital ship, on the 10th of the service of Canada.

The Austrian Ambassador is still in London. It is understood that Anglo-Austrian relations are unchanged. Pending the issue of the latter will be regarded as neutral. This will affect the position of the British and Russian, now believed to be in the Adriatic.

The British Consul at Vannes reports that the Austrian fleet is of 17 ships.

It is officially reported in Paris that French troops have entered Mulhausen. The French advance guard arrived at Altkich at midnight on Friday. The town was defended by a German brigade including 100, which the French carried after a fierce bayonet fight. The Germans fled in disorder. They lost heavily in a cavalry pursuit.

The Free of Wales Relief Fund has reached £600,000.

At Brussels at 10 o'clock in the evening, the Minister announced the situation is hourly improving. The co-operation of the French and Belgian troops continues successfully.

General Joffre, the French Commander-in-Chief in a proclamation, says: "Children of Alsace, after forty-four years of wonderful waiting French soldiers again tread the soil of your noble country. They are the possessors of a great work of revenge."

There is rejoicing in Paris over the first French victory on German soil, and the fighting moved on Alton.

It is stated in Brussels that the Belgian army was awaiting a night attack but all was quiet at 2 o'clock in the morning.



PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the fourth section of the Naval Reserve (Volunteers) Act, 1908 it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the King in such manner as he may think fit, to authorize His Admiralty to direct that the Volunteers under the Act, or so many or such part of them as His Majesty may deem necessary, shall be taken into naval service.
AND WHEREAS by the first section of the Naval Reserve (Mobilization) Act, 1914, it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the King, in case of any such order and when given, to revoke or vary, such directions as may be necessary in respect of calling out all or any of the said Volunteers as their occasion may require.
AND WHEREAS the King has commanded to Parliament and notified by Proclamation, that owing to the state of Public Affairs for the protection of the Empire, an emergency has arisen for ordering and directing in the said first mentioned Act it is enacted.

It is hereby notified that the King has ordered and directed that the Royal Naval Reserve be called into actual service.

VICTORIOUS BELGIUM.

8,000 Germans Killed

SEVEN GUNS CAPTURED.

Hundreds Wounded.

[VERSAILLES REVIEW'S AGENCY.]

London, Friday.

The German Ambassador left this morning for Germany.
The Bank of England discount rate is reduced to 5 per cent.
The newspapers in Brussels state that the German losses in the fighting in Belgium have reached 8,000 killed, seven guns captured, while 8,000 wounded Germans have arrived in Brussels.
The British Dominions have made magnificent and most enthusiastic offers of help, the smaller colonies as well as the larger. The Indian Empire has also sent warm-hearted offers.

The most splendid Anglo-French naval and military operations are proceeding. The Germans are pouring into Belgium, consolidating the country on its lowest defence.

WAR LOCALITIES.

WHEREIN THE FIGHTS ARE

Many of us are ready bravely to admit that our geographical knowledge has grown somewhat rusty. While most people retain a vague memory of the map of Europe, quite a number, apparently, find it difficult to state of hand exactly where the fighting is, for instance. Without further apology, therefore, we offer the following particulars to those who care to have them.

AUSTRIA-HUNGARY—Southern boundary: Germany, Poland, Southern boundary: Russia (Anatolia), Servia, Rumania, Eastern: Rumania, Russia, Western: Austria (Sea, Venetia, Italy), France (Germany).

BELGIUM—Northern: Holland, Southern: France, Eastern: France, Western: France, North Sea.

FRANCE—Northern: English Channel, Belgium, Southern: Spain, Mediterranean Sea, Eastern: Italy, Switzerland, Germany, Western: Bay of Biscay.

GERMANY—Northern: North Sea, Denmark, Sweden, Baltic Sea, Southern: Switzerland, Austria, Eastern: Bohemia (Austria), Poland, Western: France, Belgium, Holland.

HOLLAND—Northern: North Sea, Southern: Belgium, Eastern: France, Western: North Sea.

ITALY—Northern: Switzerland, Austria, Southern: Mediterranean Sea, Eastern: Adriatic Sea, Western: Tyrrhenian Sea, France.

RUSSIA (in Europe)—Northern: Arctic Ocean, Southern: Austria, Rumania, Bulgaria, Black Sea, Asia Minor, Eastern: Japan, Western: Baltic Sea, Sweden, Austria, Prussia, Italy, Sea, Sweden.

SWITZERLAND—Northern: Southern: France, Belgium, Holland, Eastern: Holland, Germany, Denmark, Western: Southern: England.

RUSSIAN ASIA—Northern: Manchuria, Poland (Russia), Southern: Persia.

Eastern: Russia, Western: Denmark, Prussia. (Most of Germany's sea-board is on the Baltic, which is connected with the North Sea by the Kiel Canal.)

LIMBURG (Holland), reported to have been invaded by German troops, is on the north-eastern border of Belgium, joining Prussia.

AZENSTUCHOVA—BENTZIN and KALINZ, invaded by the Germans, are in Poland, on the Prussian border.

LIEGE, on the river Meuse, is a Belgian town in a province of the same name, 20 or 30 miles from the German border. **EUPON** is on the border in the same vicinity. **VERVIERES** is a Belgian town between Liege and the border.

AYWALLEK is in Limburg. Cannon are reported to have been heard here.

EYSDEN, **VISE** and **ARBENTON** are, apparently, towns in villages in the province of Liege.

SAMUR is a town on the Meuse, southwest of Liege, in a province of the same name.

The Belgian province of Limburg plus that of the same name in Holland, Maastricht, whence the people of Vise are said to have fled, is between Limburg and Liege.

BIALA, from which the Germans are said to have fallen back, is a town in Poland in the government of Siedlce.

GREAT AFRIKANDER.

JAN HOPMEYER'S LIFE

The biography of Jan Hopmeyer which was published recently in the work many of his nephews who, after graduating at the University of the Cape with a double first in Mathematics and Classics, is some 300 pages in length, not yet 20 years of age. Mr. Hopmeyer, formerly President of the Free State, collected and edited the material, research and selection among the numerous mass of material, as well as the careful shaping of the biography which over the years he had attempted to present in a comprehensive and readable form, and in order to group and power of condensation, to volume, which consists of between 300 and 400 pages, in an extraordinary production for a youth of 20.

The biographer dignifies his subject as being to present a picture of a man who has given the possibility of combining the highest feelings of a South African patriot with the fullest acceptance of responsibility as a citizen of the Empire. "The volume exhibits the author's long political career for the Union of South Africa on the basis of the amalgamation of the white races, the fundamental presuppositions of amalgamation being recognition on the side of the British of equal language rights, and on the side of the Dutch of nationality as South African."

This brought him at times into sharp conflict with his own countrymen, especially with Kruger, who on one occasion denounced him as a "traitor to the Afrikaner cause," and at other times caused him to be misunderstood by the British.

The story of the Brinkley of Brinkley and Cecil Rhodes is told with a simple candour which has something of the pathos of a historical tragedy. All the great figures of South African and Anglo-Afri history during the past 40 years come on the stage, and activities particularly of Cecil Rhodes and Mr. Chamberlain will be described with a precision of opinion. But the greatest and the young biographer's own life is clearly to have done his work in a spirit of honesty, thoroughness and logical administration for the good of the people of South Africa.

The Union Castle Steamship "Eleonora" will leave for London on Monday next and will take a further route to England.

WAR!

Germany Declares War on Russia and sends Ultimatum to France.

[LONDON LETTER'S AGENCY.]

London, August 8
A message from St. Petersburg states that Great Britain is making a bid to find a formula acceptable to both Russia and Austria, but with little hope of success.

A general mobilisation of the Russian Army has been ordered. The mobilisation is a total one of the army, which never moves as one district, and is only called out in case of actual war.

The French Government has issued a proclamation appealing to workers not to aid the enemy by agitation, the murder of Jews, shooting the Capital into disorder.

The members of the French Socialist League have been ordered to leave the country. They are believed to be in Austria.

France has prohibited the export of all toxicants.

A cable from Ottawa says that it is expected that 20,000 militia will be mobilised.

Mr. Asquith and Lord Kitchener had had audience with the King, and it is understood that Lord Kitchener and Sir Francis Wigram will leave for Egypt on Monday, the 10th August.

All international train services in Germany have been suspended and telephone communication between Germany and other countries is interrupted.

An authoritative note from Paris declares that Germany has indicated to the British as extremely grave. The French Cabinet were still considering the crisis at midnight.

The St. Petersburg correspondence of the "Times" says that a general mobilisation was declared here on the 8th July, shortly after midnight on a war footing.

A special official message from Rome states that Germany has sent an ultimatum to both Russia and France.

Denmark and Norway have declared their neutrality.

Ernest Fisher, speaking at Oslo, said that should the worst happen, Australia would help the Allies to the last man and the last shilling. Both these statements were received with ovation.

[Note.—In the haste to print the latest news by the hands of the public, a slight confusion in the Spanish Supplement issued on Sunday evening, 8th inst., has been noted. It is stated in England it is an other standard! This should have read "Germany"—not England.]

Minister Hughes, in a speech, said that Canada is loathe than ever to rally round the flag.

Germany, in her ultimatum, has asked Russia what her intentions are in mobilising her troops, and also questioned France regarding her intentions. In each case a prompt reply was requested.

It is becoming increasingly probable that they will maintain a neutral attitude.

The official ultimatum from Germany to Russia expires at noon today (Sunday).

Russia states that the French Embassy at Paris has indicated that she proposes to leave Paris tonight. If, however, she were still being made to continue the negotiations.

It is officially stated that the German Ambassador is leaving St. Petersburg.

Sweden has declared neutrality.

An emergency Cabinet meeting has been held in Ottawa. The Duke and Duchess of Cornwall are hurriedly returning.

Butler states that despite the fact of the situation, conversations at Vienna and St. Petersburg are still in progress.
