WHAT ARE THE RUSSIANS DOING?

"What are the Russians really doing?" is the question that is being asked and perhaps the question I was commissioned to answer in my Daily Mail article which has been passed to East Frisia in compliance with the terms of a correspondence agreement (made monthly).

While I might feel that the Russian position is not so serious as it is being made out to be, I should first like to eradicate from the British mind the idea of the "Russian steam-roller". Generally, I should like to point out that the Russian official accounts are strictly accurate as regards victories, but being their policy not to give up any such report until victory has been absolutely sealed, but the German do not officially report details.

My account must of necessity be somewhat technical, though I sincerely hope in many curious and interesting circumstances that would appeal to the general public. 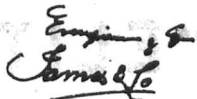

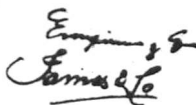
