us to probe for the reasons and when these reasons are found to see what we can each individually do to remove the cause. For Officials to suggest as we have frequently heard them do, that the fault lies only with the Settlers is foolish. Our Settlers are made up from all classes of men, Hereditary Peers, men from Univer-sities, from the Colonies and from the humblest ranks of life, Are these men antagonistic without reason? We are inclined to think not; and we feel it is to the administrative portion of Civil Service itself we must look to for the removal of this feeling, a feeling which if allowed to continue for any space of time will spell ruin to our country's prospects. On the whole, administration, are the right class, honest, clean, Britishers willing to do the work allotted to them to their best ability yet there is some-thing wanting, what it is, is difficult to say, but it is a something which we believe can only be found by a searching self-examination by each individual official from the highest rung of the ladder to the lowest.

Possibly the offending official, in the security of his monthly salary and comfortable position, is apt to look down upon the Settler, who has settled in this country in a hope of naking a home, and thus treat him with less courtesy, consideration and sympathy than they would extend to a brother official. If so we would assure them that all Settlers are not dacoits and we would ask them to try and imitate his gracious majesty. King Edward VII, who has carned the respect of the world through his sympathy, courtesy and fact.

Unity is strength and we trust that before the next General Meeting of the Settler's Association ruled to those who carry out the ruling will have entirely disappeared. Hypocritical friendliness is useless, it is essential that an official should regard the Settler as one needs fostering and a Collector in particular should be proud of Our Report of the Annual General
